### ISSUE #1: Born Yesterday (Book)

We ran the following program to address above issues from: VOP - Discovery

**Brief Description of Program: (Format, participants, content, etc.):** Host Jean Boonstra interviewed **Guest: Rachel Williams Smith** who has completed the graduate program at Andrews and is the Graduate Program Director and an Associate Professor in the Dept. of Communication at Andrews. Author of "Born Yesterday-The True Story of a Girl Born in the 20<sup>th</sup> Century But Raised In The 19 Century." God redeems each of us when we allow Him to, but Jesus's entire mission was/is redemption. (Refer to Mark 10:45). Jean's life s started to change at age 6, when her family became vegan. The next big change was when her mother told her that she had to start wearing homemade long dresses as stated in the Bible. Also, by the age of 8, she and her mother started wearing bonnets. **Brief Description of Program: (Format, participants, content, etc.):** Host Dr. Gary Chapman interviewed **Guest Kim Erickson** is an attorney and a law professor. She worked as a gymnastics coach in college to earn money to continue her education. She met her husband in college and they have 2 living children but lost a 3 year child due to strep throat. Her book "His Last Words: What Jesus Taught and Prayed in His Final Hours" is today's resource book. **Book Notes:** Imagine knowing you only have several more hours to live. Picture the faces of your loved ones gathered around you. Allow the emotions to rise up in your heart. John 13:17 records Jesus' last words to the disciples before His death, revealing what was most important to Him. When we study those words and prayers today, we enter deep into the heart of Jesus and come away changed: overwhelmed by the love of God, inspired to follow Him, and empowered to spread the gospel. His Last Words is a 7-week bible study that plumbs the depths of Jesus' final teachings to the disciples. It features a verse-by-verse study of John 13-17 and portions of John 18:21
