**Art and Culture**: The SouthCoast seeks enrichment. Local groups are bringing exhibits and other activities to residents to experience together.

**Civics/Politics:** Local and national governments have seen many changes and impactful events.

**Education**: The SouthCoast has faced many challenges in education from needing to replace aging schools to the sudden closure of the UMass Dartmouth arts campus in downtown New Bedford.
