Re: Retransmission Consent Election for Bandon, Coquille, Myrtle Point, and Reedsport, OR  
KOB1 TV, Medford, OR/Medford/Klamath Falls DMA

Dear Ms. Roberts:

By letter dated August 19, 2014, you were advised that we intended to elect must carry for television station KOB1 TV, Medford, Oregon on your cable system serving the communities listed above (including any communities not specifically listed but served by the same system, the “Cable System”). That letter was sent in error and should be disregarded as void. This notice supersedes the prior letter in all respects.

This is to advise you that, pursuant to Section 325(b) of the Communications Act and Section 76.64 of the rules of the Federal Communications Commission, KOB1 TV elects retransmission consent for the Cable System for the three year cycle beginning January 1, 2015.

You are hereby granted consent, subject to the terms of this letter, to retransmit the primary signal of KOB1, including all program-related material, as broadcast on main channel 5, over the Cable System without material degradation, interruption or alteration (except as otherwise required by law) on the basic level of service on cable channel 5 and our HD preferably on channel 305. Carriage of the station’s signal shall be done in accordance with the terms of the FCC rules applicable to the carriage of stations electing mandatory carriage rights. This consent is limited to retransmission of KOB1’s digital broadcast primary signal on the Cable System for the private home viewing of the digital signals by consumers using analog or digital television sets connected by wire to the Cable System. In no event shall you authorize or enable viewing of the Station’s digital signals by or over any other distribution technology, including without limitation Internet, mobile media, or on an “authenticated” basis.

Carriage of KOB1’s signal by the Cable System beginning January 1, 2015 shall constitute acceptance of the terms of this letter. This consent shall continue through December 31, 2017, provided KOB1 may terminate consent upon forty-five day’s written notice.
