### Section I. Issues

### Section II. Responsive Programs

The station has broadcast programming dealing with the above-referenced issues. Programming dealing with each issue is set out below.

#### A. Elder Care:

**“Legend’s Community Focus With Lorna O’Connell”** - Broadcast on December 6th, 6:00AM; Duration 30 Minutes

Guest: Sheryl Esquilin with the local Leukemia and Lymphedema Society. She discussed the different types of blood cancer and new treatments.

#### B. Health & Well Being: Issues related to the health and well being of community members.

**“Legend’s Community Focus With Lorna O’Connell”** - Broadcast on October 4th 6:00AM; Duration 30 Minutes

Guest: Dr. Robert A. Gardner, Founder and Director, Palm Beach Breast Institute. He discussed the importance of yearly mammograms and comprehensive breast examinations.

**“Legend’s Community Focus With Lorna O’Connell”** - Broadcast on October 11th, 6:00AM; Duration 30 Minutes

Guests: Sharon Horton, American Cancer Society, Stacey Halpin and Melanie Scherr, Making Strides Against Breast Cancer Walk volunteers, and Sasha Connolly, Walk Team Leader. They urged people to join a team and help find a cure for breast cancer.

**“Legend’s Community Focus With Lorna O’Connell”** - Broadcast on October 18th, 6:00AM; Duration 30 Minutes

Guests: Carrie Browne, Marge Sullivan and Sioban Gross, Healthier Jupiter Initiative, and Lauren Zuchman, Healthier Delray Beach Initiative Project Director. They explained how Palm Healthcare Foundation will distribute a \$6 million grant to fund public workshops and free seminars.

**“Legend’s Community Focus With Lorna O’Connell”** - Broadcast on November 8th, 6:00AM; Duration 30 Minutes

Guest: Carol Presseser from the National Alliance of Mental Illness. She explained the impact on families and listed many of the resources and programs available through the Palm Beach Chapter.

**“Legend’s Community Focus With Lorna O’Connell”** - Broadcast on November 29th, 6:00AM; Duration 30 Minutes

Dr. Karin Blumof, Bariatric Surgeon, Delray Medical Center. She detailed the three main surgical procedures used to reverse morbid obesity along with risks, recovery time and success rate of each.

The program promoted the Pink Stydes auction and fashion show to raise funds and promote breast cancer awareness, and detailed how they are helping the underserved communities.
