7. Wildfire Awareness – April 11-12 News Interviews - 7:35am - 3 min each	Bitterroot RC&D holds conference on wildfire and home preparation in Hamilton. Over a dozen speakers and how to prepare for next fire season.
8. Aquatic Invasive Species – News – May23 – 7:35am - 3 min	To prevent invasive species such as zebra mussels, MT Fish Wildlife and Parks has set up inspection stations, including in Bitterroot Valley.
9. Low income housing – Interview – April News - 7:30am – 2 min June Interview – 8:20 am – 5 minutes	Habitat for Humanity breaks ground on a new low-income home in April and requests more volunteers in interview in June.
10. Snowpack levels – News – April, May, June at 7:30am – 2 min	Once-a-month reports on mountain snowpack dropping below average. Officials worry about summer streamflow in Bitterroot Valley.
11. Hospital Intensive Care Unity Fund Drive – Interview – May 1, 2, 3 – 7:30am – 3 min each	The Marcus Daly Memorial Hospital Foundation starts a public fundraising campaign to raise over \$3 million for an expanded ICU facility at Hamilton hospital.
