#### MICHIGAN TRAFFIC DEATHS UP 10 % FROM LAST YEAR

Michigan traffic deaths rose 10 % last year as alcohol-involved and teen and motorcyclist traffic deaths increased. The bicyclist fatalities are up 57% from 21 in 2014 to 33 % in 2015. The director of the Michigan Office of Highway Safety Planning says officials plan to work with the University of Mich Transportation Research Institute to identify factors that may of played a role.
