5. MIN	ORITIES:	Racial relations, Native American, Latino, Black, Asian and other ethnic groups' cultural and economic development, civil rights, immigration issues, cultural diversity.
6. POL	ITICS:	Government, state and city issues, local & national issues, red tape, voting, civic duties, patriotism, veterans.
7. ECO	NOMY:	Cost of living, financial security, small businesses, economic policies, recession, rebuilding the economy of So. Cal, housing, homeless.
8. ENV	IRONMENT	C: Drought/saving water, Natural disasters, traffic, pollution, garbage, beaches/parks, city cleanup efforts, global warming, going green, wildlife preservation.
9. WO N	MEN:	Women's rights/equality, health issues, pregnancy issues, abortion, single parent issues, domestic abuse.
