10. **RELATIONSHIPS:** Dating, marriage, divorce, sex gender diversity, social influences and peer pressure, sexual needs and issues, pregnancy, abortion, single parent issues.

Mara was born and raised in Long Island, a suburb of New York City. She attended the University of Rochester graduating with double majors in Psychology and Economics. After college, Mara worked for Drexel Burnham Lambert, Swiss Bank Corporation and Credit Suisse First Boston where she was Vice President of Foreign Exchange Operations.

Mara has organized several fundraisers throughout her children's school and extracurricular activities. She is a past board member for the Pediatric Cancer Foundation in New York where she co-chaired the Foundation's annual Neiman Marcus sponsored luncheon two years in a row.

In January 2007, her husband, Kenneth, and three children relocated to California. It is here they chose to establish Kenneth's OBGYN practice. Mara was the Office Manager for seven years until May 2014 when, at the age of 48 years old, she experienced a manic episode and was diagnosed with bipolar disorder. Her mother also had lived with bipolar. She and Kenneth have a child who has been identified to have Asperger's Syndrome and ADHD adding to mental health issues in their family dynamics.

When Mara discovered Mental Health Awareness Month was in the month of May and that it was not nationally recognized, she vowed to let the entire world know of this month and to honor it every year. She calls her manic episode her "magical episode" now that she recognizes its significance as a gift propelling her to form a non-profit entity. **FREE Parking** – On-site self- parking is available in any student parking space in Lot B and on levels 2 through 4 in the Parking Structure– see attached map.

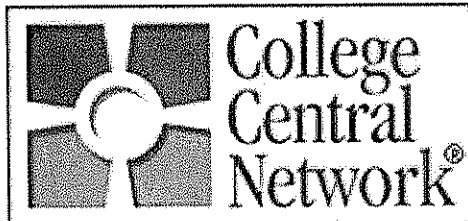
