





The Sand Fire that broke out on Friday afternoon off the 14 freeway near Sand Canyon has pushed more evacuations (1,500 homes already evacuated). So far, the massive flame has destroyed 18 homes (threatening 2,000 as they're on its path), burned down 33,000 acres, and is only 10% contained. Reportedly there is more than 1,673 firefighters, 122 engines, 39 hand crews, 15 helicopters and 8 dozes contributing to putting the fire out. The Acton evacuation includes houses along Agua Dulce Canyon Road north of 14 freeway, Crown Valley north of 14 freeway, and all of Soledad Canyon/Bootlegger Canyon, according to LA County fire officials. The 14 freeway going northbound was shut down from the I-5 to Soledad Canyon, while 14 freeway southbound was closed from I-5 to Avenue M.
