

**STATEMENT REGARDING
EEO PUBLIC FILE REPORT**

This statement is being provided for the station employment unit consisting of KABE-CD, KBTF-DT and KUVI-DT (each a “Station” and, collectively, the “Station Employment Unit”) for the period covering August 1, 2022 through July 31, 2023 (“Reporting Period”). The Station Employment Unit has fewer than five full-time employees as of August 1, 2023, and thus is exempt from the requirement to upload an EEO Public File Report to the online public inspection files for the Stations for the Reporting Period.¹
