

The issues listed below were address by WBAL-AM programming during the second quarter of 2013:

1. **Baltimore City Prison Corruption** – Extensive coverage about the discovery of corruption in Baltimore City prisons and the indictments that have followed.
2. **Community** – Extensive coverage of a train derailment in Rosedale and dangerous weather in the listening area and the tornadoes that devastated areas in Oklahoma. Discussion about various community events taking place such as: job fairs on Tax Day, the American Beer Craft Week and an un-timely cruise ship fire.
3. **Crime** –Discussion about the ongoing problems of bullying and the sex-trafficking. Also discussion about general crimes in the area and how the crime rates are rising.
4. **Economics** – Extensive discussion about: jobs, taxes, budget plans and Sequestration.
5. **Education** – Discussion about the resignation of Baltimore City School Board CEO, Dr. Andre Alonso. Also discussion about college tuition costs and choosing the right college for your students.
6. **Environment** – Extensive discussion about the tragic tornados that ripped through Oklahoma. Also, discussions about global warming, cicadas and the upcoming Hurricane season.
7. **Ethics** –Discussion about the use of Drones by the government on American citizens. Also discussion about racial extremists.
8. **Foreign Relations** – Discussion about the unrest in Syria, North Korea and Egypt.
9. **Government** – Discussion about the end of the legislative session, Obamacare, gun control. Immigration and corruption in the military.
10. **Health** – Discussion about Autism Awareness in our community, obesity, the dangers of tanning beds and a new limb lengthening center at Sinai Hospital.
11. **Judicial** – Discussion about the death penalty appeal and Prop 8.
12. **Politics** – Coverage of President Obama’s press conference about Scandalgate. Also general discussion about political issues in our area.
13. **Public Safety** –Discussion about enhancing security in MD schools and the dangers of texting while driving. Also discussion about general public safety in the aftermath of the Boston Marathon Bombing.
14. **Scandalgate** – Extensive discussion about the DOJ, IRS, AP and NSA scandals.
15. **Sports** – Coverage of the Preakness Stakes, the O’s, and the supplemental budget being provided to TU for their baseball program.
16. **Terrorism** – Wall-to-wall coverage the day of the Boston Marathon bombing and the days after the tragic event along with the capture of both suspects. Also, ongoing discussion about the second suspect and his arrest.
17. **Transportation** –Extensive discussion about speed cameras, parking problems and airline travel.
