Issue: Support for Veteran Programs

The WBUT Breakfast Club conducted a two-hour broadcast for the Independence Health System Caring Angels program. During the broadcast, discussion with representatives included the pediatric emergency services, and the services provided by the Family First Resource Center. The Caring Angel program provides funding for both entities through the Butler Health System Foundation so these services are available to families and assures any children will be provided emergency care, even if they don't have insurance or funds to pay.
