Quarterly Issues/Programs List for WMNC AM & FM July 1st - September 30th - 2017 Placed in the Public File –October 5th, 2017

Section I. Issues.

The stations have identified the following issues as significant issues facing our community in this quarter:

- A. Opioid Epidemic: Opioid addiction has become a major problem in the Unifour Area with the City of Hickory being one of the top cities in the state for opioid addiction.
- **B.** Aging: As the population of Burke County gets older, programs for the aging are in need in the area, affordable retirement housing, crime prevention for the elderly, and other services for older adults..
- C. Economy: The Catawba County area suffered from loss of wages, stagnant business development, sliding home values, and lack of retail sales as the recession takes its toll on Burke, Catawba and Caldwell Counties.
- **D.** Health Care: The Unifour area continues to have one high rates of obesity, diabetes, heart disease and cancer in North Carolina.
