The following program descriptions describe some of the news stories and reports aired by KIAH during the relevant quarter. News stories are listed chronologically in under each issue type.

**Issue: EDUCATION**

**Date: September 15, 2013.** You know what they say... money talks! Officials with Houston Independent School District picked up on that memo. They created the incentive program Youth Watch. School Support Services Officer Lupita Hinojosa said, "This actually started on the very first day of school when we realized that some of our students had not returned to school." She said about 4,000 students district-wide were not in attendance on the first day. School officials are now calling on current students to help. If a student brings in a classmate who has dropped out, he or she gets a hundred dollar gift card. There are stipulations, of course. Re-enrolled students have to stay enrolled through the fall semester or meet graduation requirements by December. "Go out, talk to your friends, talk to your cousins. Encourage them, motivate them, tell them to come back. Tell them that there are options because teens listen to other teens," said Hinojosa. The deadline is September 26th. **Date: August 16, 2013.** Here's something for you gabby coffee drinkers out there to chat about. A study out, now connects heavy coffee drinking with higher death risk in men and women younger than 55.

According to the online medical journal, Mayo Clinic Proceedings, guys younger than 55 who drink more than 28 cups of coffee a week, (that's 4 cups a day) are 56% more likely to die from any cause. Women drinking that much coffee under 55 are, looking at double the normal risk of death.

The study looked at 43,727 men and women ages 20-87 from 1971 to 2002 and did not find a higher death risk for adults older than 55. Reasons for the higher death risk among young adults aren't clear because experts over the years have found both health benefits and problems associated with drinking coffee. But think about lifestyle choices for a second; heavy coffee drinking is also tied to bad habits like sleeping late, eating a poor diet, lack of fitness and smoking.

The authors of the study say more research is needed, it may not be the coffee killing people, but the lifestyle associated with adults under 55 drinking so much of it. Like all thing folks, moderation is the key here. Duration: 02:19

**Issue: GOVERNMENT**

**Date: August 2, 2013.** What a difference a day makes.
