

ISSUES AND PROGRAMS THIRD QUARTER 2022

ISSUE: CHILDREN'S PROGRAMMING

Glory Stories...30 Minutes at 10:00

7/15/22 ... Blessed Jose Sanchez del Rio details the life of a boy who held onto his Faith against the power of the state. He was tortured and eventually martyred but he refused to deny his Faith. He is an example of bravery in the face of unfathomable odds.

7/29/22 ... St. Miguel and St. Therese of Lisieux: Part One details St. Miguel's martyrdom and his good example of faith. Part Two details St. Therese's good example to children, specifically her willingness to sacrifice for others.

8/5/22/22...Mass responses and prayers. Teaches children the responses at Mass as well as the various parts of Mass and a greater respect for Jesus' sacrifice and the Eucharist.

8/19/22....St. Cecilia and Blessed Kateri Part One details a Roman girl, St. Cecilia, who faced religious detractors in the Third Century with the spirit of song. She is now the Patron Saint of Music. Part two details the story of a Mohawk woman who gave up everything and endured the scorn of her family in order to practice the Christian faith.

9/2/22 ... St. Joan of Arc details the trials and tribulations of St. Joan of Arc, an historical as well as a spiritual leader. Children will learn about her fight to save the French people and will learn to be courageous even in the face of overwhelming odds.

9/23/22 ... St. Rose details the life of St. Rose who endured suffering and became the first saint from the New World. Her life teaches children how to deal with suffering and difficult times..

ISSUE: YOUNG ADULT CONTENT

Beyond Damascus...60 minutes at 20:00 Beyond Damascus... 60 Minutes... The Beyond Damascus program engages young adults each week with stories of conversions, testimonies and faith journeys.

7/9/22... This week the hosts discuss what it means to be a Christian in the world today...how to be in the world, but not of it.

7/30/22This week host Dan DeMatte is joined by Fr. Delacey and Mary Sally Santiago from the Archdiocese of Philadelphia who share their own faith journeys and baptism in the Holy Spirit.

8/06/22Hosts Brad Pierron, Dan DeMatte and Aaron Richards discuss the Eucharist and the difference it makes among the youth that participate in the Catholic Youth Summer Camp program.

8/12/22The hosts continue to discuss the positive influence of the Eucharist on those involved in the Summer Youth Camp, both campers and counselors/support staff alike.

9/06/22This week the hosts discuss conversion, choosing to focus on the conversion of Shia LaBeouf and the interview that he participated in with Bishop Robert Barron.

9/19/22This week the program concentrates on the topic of divine inheritance, what it means and how listeners can apply it to their own lives.

ISSUE: FAMILY, PARENTING AND RELATIONSHIPS

The Doctor is In...57 minutes... at 1300 Dr. Ray Guarendi, a clinical psychologist, answers listeners' questions concerning the healthy choices on raising their children.

7/6/22 ... Today, Dr. Ray takes a call from a woman who asks his advice on whether she should counsel younger relatives on being more aware of their children's safety.

7/19/22 ... Dr. Ray takes a call from a gentleman who is being denied access to his grandchildren because he has not received the COVID vaccine.

8/4/22 ... Dr. Ray receives a call from a woman seeking suggestions on how to relate to her daughter who doesn't believe in God's existence.

8/17/22 ... Dr. Ray talks to a caller who is discerning the priesthood and seeks Dr. Ray's opinion as to whether he is doing it for the right reasons.

9/1/22 ...Dr. Ray takes a call from someone who suffers from agoraphobia and also takes a call from a listener who has had to deal with suicide and the threat of suicide among immediate family members.

9/8/22... Dr. Ray discusses how to achieve spiritual growth and attain peace in one's life by letting go of personal grievances.

ISSUE: EDUCATIONAL

7/5/22 guest Tim Staples takes questions from callers regarding Nancy Pelosi and reception of communion, the brown scapular and whether Judaism recognizes hell and the devil.

7/19/22 guest Colin Donovan answers questions about the ability to receive absolution while in the process of divorcing one's spouse from another faith, the church's teaching on homosexuality and the meaning of 1 Corinthians 11.

8/5/22 guest Rose Sweet takes questions regarding divorce, co-habitation and the annulment process.

8/03/22 ... Lawrence Feingold discusses the mystery of the Eucharist with AI. Father George Elliot presents practical tips for discernment, while John McGreery talks about the early years of the Jesuit order.

8/16/10/22... On this show, Zac Kreigman joins AI to discuss what happened when he criticized the Black Lives Matter organization, while Father Andrew Young shares his experiences as a military chaplain in Afghanistan.

7/8/22 ... Today, Johnnette discusses how God is with us throughout periods of suffering and the need for intercessory prayer. Callers request prayer and discuss loss and how sharing our experiences can benefit others.

7/26/22... Today, Johnnette recalls the piety exhibited by her grandmother, especially in regard to her prayer life. Callers share their own stories and memories of their grandparents.

8/5/22 ,, , ; ; ; . Today's show featured a variety of topics, including the reception of communion after divorce and how to discern whether one is in union with the church.

8/17/22 Today, host Johnnette Williams is joined by guest Sue Brinkmann to discuss Ouija boards and tarot cards.

9/1/22 at ... Today, Johnnette discusses workplace issues with a number of callers, including one caller who faces a great deal of conflict and tension at work from younger colleagues and a caller whose son is fearful of working.

9/16/22 ... On this show, Johnnette discusses the virtue of patience and how St. Therese struggled to overcome her lack of patience through perseverance in prayer. Callers share their own experiences and favorite saints.
