1) KSEY broadcast the regular monthly meetings of Seymour City Council for the benefit of the shut-ins and elderly in our community. The Meetings are the 3rd Thursday of every month. Meetings were broadcast at 7pm on the following dates. 01/20, 02/17 and 03/18. We feel this is a valuable public service to the shut-in and elderly who can not attend City Council Meetings. The City Council meetings are broadcast on KSEY AM and FM.

2) KSEY FM and AM Broadcast a 22 minute weekly show called THIS WEEK IN TEXAS every Sunday morning at 5:05 am. The show is produced by the Texas State Network and explores all issues in the news affecting Texas. A complete log of all shows and topics is available thru The Texas State Network.

3) KSEY FM broadcast meal on Wheels menus and other Meals On Wheels news. The menus are aired Monday thru Friday at 6:45am, 7:45am, 8:45am, 9:45am, 10:45am and 11:45am. We feel this is a valuable service to our clients. Our broadcasts give them enough time to make other lunch arrangements if they don't want or, for health reasons, can't eat planned menu. The 6:45 and 7:45 menus are broadcast on both AM and FM and 9:45, 10:45 and 11:45 am on KSEY FM.

4) KSEY's EAS encoder-decoder has a telephone interface. The City of Seymour has access to the system to immediately broadcast local emergencies. The city has 24/7 access to our EAS system and can use the system to be determined by the Police Chief of EMS Manager in Baylor County. We also broadcast a series of announcements urging citizens to buy EAS radios. We stock EAS radios at KSEY and sell to citizens at cost.

5) Agriculture and farm related issues are important to all citizens in Baylor county and most surrounding counties. We broadcast several farm and agri related shows every day, Monday thru Friday. We do a farm show from 5:00 am till 5:30 am on both KSEY AM/FM. Other Farm shows are broadcast on KSEY FM from 7:00 till 7:30am and 12:15 till 1:00pm..

6) We have determined that Seymour and Baylor County has a large population of children in need and are below the poverty level. This information from the Child Welfare League. On March 30 we donated air time, equipment and tech assistance to broadcast a live remote to raise money for the Child Welfare Board. The money is used to medicine, eye glasses - etc for kids in need in our community. The on air auction was broadcast from 6:30 pm till 11:00pm. The auction raised close to \$3500. The program was broadcast on KSEY AM and FM.

6) KSEY AM Broadcast a COMMUNITY DAY BOOK everyday Monday Through Friday. The show is :60 and is broadcast every hour from 9:00 till 8:00pm. The air time is 20 past the hour. The show is free for all community service and non profit groups. ON KSEY FM we Air the Day Book Monday Thru Friday at 15 past the hour from 6am till 8pm

7) The entire KSEY FM and AM listening area still remains under drought conditions, now for 5 years. In the first quarter we broadcast 8 psa's per day Monday thu Friday urging listeners to use water wisely.
