I. AGRICULTURE AND COMMERCE

News at 6pm – July 31, 2007

Amanda Manatt reported that bingo players across Arkansas are breaking out their cards tonight as a law allowing charitable bingo takes effect. 163 organizations are registered to operate bingo, including the Moose Lodge in Sherwood where earlier in the day Bob Douglas checked the bingo equipment one more time before the first game got going. The lodge has spent over two hundred thousand dollars on equipment and a new parking lot all to get ready for bingo. There will be some regulations. There can only be two games a week, five hours long, and total prizes can't exceed seventy five hundred dollars. Plus there is a one cent tax on all cards. That is to cover the states cost of overseeing the games. As for the players, they are just ready to play bingo.

News at 6pm –August 13, 2007

Christina Munoz reported that hot temperatures are not just a threat to the elderly; they are also affecting the poultry industry. Pilgrim's Pride lost more than 7-thousand chickens this weekend due to power outages near El Dorado. Farmers across Arkansas are working overtime to make sure their birds stay cool. Chickens can't sweat and if they overheat they can die in a short period of time, and the heat wave is forcing poultry farmers to use more electricity and more water increasing their costs.

News on *Nightside at 10 p.m.* – September 5, 2007

Jessica Dean reported heavy rains in Arkansas prove to be both good and bad for farmers in the natural state. While some crops needed the rain, others were hampered by the heavy downpours. After nearly a month without rain in some areas of the state, many people were pleased to see today's rain, but for farmers it was a mixed blessing. Wednesday's rain pounded the ground, flooded some areas and left one driver to climb out of her car to avoid high flood waters. A system from Texas moved in and produced a lot of widespread rain. There was almost three inches of rain in some areas but as the raindrops fell, Stuttgart rice fields, which are normally crowded for harvest this time of year, were empty. Most of the farmers were very satisfied with the rain, even through they wanted to keep harvesting rice. Crop consultant Mark Maier says the previously dry rice fields created good conditions for harvest, however now the harvest will be delayed because of the rain. Once they get started back cutting rice it will be muddy and it will slow them down considerably. Maier says the recent rain should not effect rice prices, but if the precipitation continues we could see an increase in price when the rice hits the shelves. But the news is good when it comes to soy beans, which are still around three weeks away from harvest. The rain meant farmers could save some money they would have spent on irrigation. As far as drought conditions go throughout the state, northeast Arkansas still needs 6 to 9 inches to make up the rain deficit while central Arkansas needs 3 to 6 inches.

II. CONSUMER AND LABOR

Jason Pederson reported some Medicare recipients who switched insurance plans over the winter are only now finding out that their new coverage isn't as good as their old. There is a concentration of complaints in one southeast Arkansas town involving one plan. Suzette Russell helps Bradley county citizens with their medical needs. She says many need a lot more help after signing up for Pyramid Life, one of the many Medicare advantages offered to Arkansans. Russell says seniors were told that the insurance was supplemental, free to Bradley county residents, and easy to switch if they later changed their minds. Pyramid Life officials say brokers undergo intensive training, customers get a telephone interview at the time of sale and a follow-up welcome call and pyramid enjoys 96 percent positive customer feedback. Ms. Russell says with traditional Medicare, patients wouldn't get a bill. Now that there is a 15 percent co-pay, she fears many are avoiding medical treatment.

News on *Live* at 5pm – August 3, 2007

Jessica Dean reported that as the summer temperatures continue to rise one central Arkansas city is doing something to help its residents cope with the heat and the cost of keeping cool. The city of North Little Rock announced today its plans to assist residents with energy conservation and heat relief. Last December, the North Little Rock city council agreed to a 38 percent increase in the city's electric rates-now in these hot summer months the city is doing something to help residents cope with the cost of energy bills and the heat itself. In North Little Rock's new plan, the city has set up six informational kiosks at the locations you see on your screen. At these kiosks, residents can learn more about energy conservation, home weatherization and assistance on energy bills. The city also plans to provide a cool place for people to go during days when the heat index reaches 105 or above. Patrick Hays, North Little Rock mayor said "we want to try to do everything we can to minimize the health hazards that are certainly associated with the kind of weather we are facing."

The four emergency heat relief centers are spread across the city...you can get more information about them by calling 340-5454. The city and the fire department have also teamed up to collect and distribute box fans. If you want to donate or receive a fan you can call the North Little Rock fire department.

News on *Daybreak* – September 28, 2007

Kristin Fisher reported after a two-year-long lawsuit, electronic gambling at Oaklawn and Southland Park gets the green light from the state's highest court. Electronic gambling is here to stay according to the Arkansas Supreme Court. There was nothing irrational or arbitrary about the legislature's decision to authorize wagering on electronic games of skill at the state's establishments. Officials with oaklawn are thrilled. "We're excited about this and very pleasantly surprised with the result because it's been a long time in coming." The family council action committee filed the lawsuit almost two years ago. They claimed the state's two racetracks were given too much power. They also alleged county voters were disenfranchised by the city-only elections on electronic gambling.

"We believe that our arguments still have merit, and we believe that what they are doing in Hot Springs and West Memphis is really outside the bounds of the law." But the state's highest court has given electronic gambling the green light... opening the doors to both expansion and job creation. "It means we will be able to keep some people working all year round, lot more people than ever before. We really think it will do some kick-starting to the local and state economies." Oaklawn says they are seriously considering expanding their operations, but their priority right now is on the live racing season.

III. CRIME AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE

Scott Inman Reported four people were stabbed over the weekend during a bikers' meeting in eureka springs. An altercation between members of the Hell's Angels and a rival gang, the Bandidos, resulted in four members of the Bandidos being stabbed. Two people suffered critical injuries and were taken to Washington county hospitals. An additional 60 law enforcement officials were on duty for the weekend event. Around three hundred members of the hell's angels were in eureka springs for a national meeting.

News on *Nightside* – August 22, 2007

Scott Inman reported bank robberies are usually solved, but sometimes, it may take a while. That's the case in tonight's Crimestoppers report of a robbery that we covered last month. Police would like you to take a second look. On July 16th police responded to a bank robbery at the bank of the Ozarks on Rodney Parham. Bank employees told them a man displayed a handgun and demanded money. The tellers turned over the cash and the robber quickly fled. It's a crime that has remained unsolved for over a month now and police are looking to our viewers for help. Officer Cassandra Davis of the Little Rock police said "There was a lot of traffic during that time but we are hoping someone will recognize the suspect." He's described as a white male with facial hair in glasses and he was wearing a striped shirt. He is likely around 5-foot-9 or 10, and weighs about 180 pounds. He appeared to be in his mid 50's and just like we reported last month, there is a reward offered by Crimestoppers and by the banker's association. The banker's association is offering an additional \$5000 reward for the arrest and conviction of this suspect. They are hoping with this additional offer, someone will come forward who can identify this suspect. If you have information that can help police call the Crimestoppers hotline your call will be kept confidential.

Christina Munoz reported that a man found floating on a life raft near Cuba is a fugitive accused of robbing a batesville walmart. FBI agents say Kirby Archer of Strawberry, Arkansas and Guillermo Zarabozo of Hialeah, Florida were found in good condition on a raft in the Florida straights near Cuba. Coast guard officials say Archer and Zarabozo paid a boat captain and his crew 4-thousand dollars to drop them off in the Bahamas. The boat sailed from Miami on Saturday but the Coast Guard found the vessel near the Bahamas yesterday with no one on board. Still missing are the boat's Captain Jake Branam, Kelly Branam, Scott Campbell, and Sammy Cary. The FBI says Archer is the same man who stole 100-thousand dollars from the Wal-Mart where he worked as a customer service manager.

IV. DEFENSE AND VETERAN AFFAIRS (Secretary of State)

News on *Daybreak* – July 26, 2007

Beth Hunt reported that President Bush is getting recommendations on how to improve veterans care today. Poor conditions at Walter Reed Medical Center prompted the president to create a special panel to look into the issue. Commission members salute the quality of the medical treatment wounded veterans get, but want to eliminate some of the red tape afterward. The report will focus on a few simple, do-able proposals, including increased benefits for family members to make it easier for them to help and simplifying the rules determining disability.

News at 6 p.m. – August 24, 2007

Kristin Fisher reported sixty soldiers with the Arkansas National Guard's 185th aviation regiment returned home this morning. This is the same regiment which lost three soldiers in a black-hawk helicopter crash last January. It was a bittersweet homecoming because these soldiers were seeing their own families and the families of their fallen friends. Hundreds of friends and family gathered at Little Rock National Airport to welcome home their heroes after a year-long deployment in Iraq. It's been sixteen months since specialist Veronica Williams last saw her little boy. She said "It feels so good to see him. I've been away for so long, everything has changed. He was just a year and a half when I left. He just turned three." While he's been busy growing she's been conducting "troop movement operations" out of Balad Airbase in Iraq. She is just trying to pray and make it back because not everybody makes it back. In fact three of her fellow soldiers did not make it back. Sergeant John Gary Brown, Major Michael Vernon Taylor, and Sergeant William Warren were killed last January when their blackhawk helicopter was shot down near Baghdad. "No one expected that to happen, let alone to as many people as it happened to at once and it was completely devastating to all of us" Williams said. Many of their family members wanted to be at the airport to meet the friends of their fallen heroes including Sergeant Brown's twin brother. There are still roughly 12-hundred Arkansas guard members deployed in the global war on terror.

News on Saturday *Nightside* 10pm – September 15, 2007

Pamela Smith reported that residents bid a final farewell to marine sergeant native to Malvern Arkansas. Sergeant Michael Joe Yarbrough was one of four marines who died in combat September sixth in Iraq. He was on his third tour of duty and was scheduled to return home in November when he was killed by a roadside bomb. Residents lined the streets and waved American flags as a horse-drawn carriage with Yarbrough's casket went by. Marines served as pallbearers and the service was conducted with full military honors. Family members say they're touched by the outpour of support. Yarbrough's Uncle Doug Fendley said "I think it's wonderful, all this patriotic support has turned out here today to mourn this great loss, especially the Vietnam vets that are here did not get a welcome home, and never were thanked for their service for them, this kind of brings it back and brings closure to that." Sergeant Yarbrough would have been 25 Monday. He was the 51st Arkansan to be killed in Iraq since the war started in 2003.

V. EDUCATION AND YOUTH

News at 6pm –July 26, 2007

Michelle Rupp reported superintendents across the state are scrambling to fill critical positions within their districts. The superintendent at Malvern schools says over the last 5 years applicants have been on the decline. He attributes the lack of teachers to fewer college students becoming education majors, a large number of teachers are retiring and more money being offered to teach out of state. Right now Malvern is in need of a ninth grade physical science teacher, and since that is part of the core curriculum set by the state, not hiring this position is not an option.

News on *Live* at 5 p.m. – August 22, 2007

Heather Crawford reported that the Cabot School District started the school year Monday with a big boost in attendance. Now more than nine thousand students are enrolled in the district and the growth there is only expected to continue. Heather talked with the new superintendent who said "It's the third fastest growing city in Arkansas, and more people in Cabot means more students." In just five years the school district has seen its enrollment jump by more than 1600 and everyday more students are added to the roster. By years end the district expects the student population to grow by up to 425 students compared to last year. The biggest growth is in k through 4th grade - and this week the city's eighth elementary school, Stagecoach, opened its doors to about 500 kids. It's a challenge to meet the growth demands. Superintendent, Dr. Tony Thurman said "We're looking at an increase in busing, we've increased our buses from 85 to 90 routes and we'll need to increase those again next week. People come here for schools. There's not a lot of industry in Cabot but the main draw is we offer a great school system." In addition to the rapid growth Cabot's Junior High North was destroyed in a fire last year and won't reopen for about 18 months. This year those 7th and 8th graders have been moved to the high school's campus where there are now about 3000 students and nine portables. You don't really see any overcrowding until lunchtime which they're working out right now. But with the population only expected to increase - the district is now working on creating a long range plan. District leaders plan to visit other school districts in the coming weeks that have experienced similar growth to learn how they've dealt it in hopes of getting some ideas.

News on *Daybreak* – September 25, 2007

Beth Hunt reported good news this morning for the Bald Knob School District. The State Board of Education voted unanimously to allow the district to remain independent, at least for now. The board is giving the district more time to reach their 2-million dollar goal. The state took control of the fiscally distressed district last month firing the superintendent and the school board as of this week. Bald Knob has raised one-and-a-half million dollars, adjusted their operating budget, and will soon vote on a sales tax to help ease the cash flow but officials say the district's road to independence is still a long one. Ken James, Arkansas Education Commissioner said "This is not over...they're going to have cash flow issues." The district has until November to raise the balance of the money needed. The state will continue to oversee all decisions made by acting superintendent James Staggs.

VI. HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES

News on *Daybreak* – July 26, 2007

Jessica Dean reported a new report puts the state of Arkansas near the bottom of the list for the health and welfare of children. According to this year's kids count report, Arkansas ranks 45th out of the 50 states when it comes to children's well being. Arkansas receives mixed reviews from the 2007 kids count report. Overall Arkansas comes in 45th in the nation for children's well being, while Minnesota is number one and Mississippi 50th. The natural state gets its lowest ranking-47th- when it comes to child death rates-something local pediatricians say are often preventable. We do have a lower seat belt use ratio in our state-parents that don't buckle up themselves are less likely to buckle up their children, so if we would all buckle up more, the children would be safer. The news is not all bad, Arkansas got its highest ranking, 27th, for the percentage of teens who are high school dropouts-that number dropped from 12 percent in 2000 to 8 percent in 2005. Ironically, children's advocates say, education will ultimately be the key to improvements in the future.

News on *Live at 5* – August 23, 2007

Kristin Fisher reported that Saline County is dealing with a big number of stray animals. A public hearing has been set for next Tuesday to address the problem. The quorum court is sending out surveys ahead of Tuesday's meeting to find out what the public thinks should be done. The problem is not so much in Benton or Bryant. It's outside city limits where there's no animal control and the only shelter is full. The animal control center in Benton says they receive at least 20 calls every day from people out in the county asking where they can take abandoned animals. The only answer is the Saline County Humane Society and they're above capacity. Even if they could accept more animals they don't have enough funds or employees to pick-up strays. They say the only solution is a shelter funded by the county. Ann Sanders of the Saline Co Humane Society said "If someone picks up an animal out in the county, there really is no where to take it at this point and that's what we're hoping the county will do is open up some type of facility to help house additional animals." The public hearing is set for next Tuesday at 6 pm at the Saline County courthouse. If you would like to fill out a survey call the Saline County Judge's office at 303-5640.

News on *Nightside at 10pm* – September 4, 2007

Christina Munoz reported that it's known as the silent killer... more than 22-thousand women will get it this year... and more 15-thousand will die from it. We're talking about ovarian cancer... and it's the topic of a rally at the state capitol tomorrow morning. Leah Elliott brushes away tears as she thinks about what it was like to lose her hair. . . one of the many side effects of chemotherapy. But for Leah... simply getting an accurate diagnosis was a battle long before the treatment began. The thing about ovarian cancer is the symptoms are sort of vague, kind of non-specific. It's bloating, abdominal pain, things that a lot of women think are just monthly issues then after more than three months of being misdiagnosed Leah was told those dreaded words. . ."you have cancer." Fortunately her kind of ovarian cancer was slow-growing and surgery and chemotherapy worked.

"I've got a lucky story. Had a few things been different, it would've been a completely different ballgame for me." Now Leah is a member of the Arkansas Cancer Coalition's ovarian cancer taskforce hoping to educate women about the symptoms of the often deadly disease. "We don't want to scare anyone and get everyone in a panic to the doctor's office saying this is what they have, this is what's going on but to educate them and if you've got these symptoms, if they persist, if they

go on for a couple of weeks, you need to see a doctor and just be on the safe side and get things checked out.” Symptoms include bloating, abdominal pain, difficulty eating, and urinary problems. The rally known as "Silent No More"... will be held tomorrow morning at 10 on the steps of the capitol.

VII. POLITICS (Treasury, Housing, Urban Development)

News at 6 p.m. – July 26, 2007

Christina Munoz reported the next Sherwood mayor will be decided tomorrow. Early voting continued today. Residents are deciding the run-off election between interim Mayor Bill Harmon and Sherwood city clerk Virginia Hillman. Both candidates have been knocking on doors this week talking with citizens. A hot topic in the election has been the North Hills Country Club. Harmon is a supporter of saving the course and if not, turning it into a park. Hillman, on the other hand, believes it should be developed for use of the property, along with a funding mechanism, and put on a ballot for voters to decide.

News on *Live* at 5pm – August 27, 2007

Heather Crawford reported that former US attorney Bud Cummins - who was among the federal prosecutors fired last winter - learned of Gonzales' resignation this morning. While Cummins says he thinks it's a good decision - he said today he feels sympathy for Gonzales. After nearly five years on the job as US attorney for the eastern district of Arkansas Bud Cummins was forced out in December. Now eight months later - attorney general Alberto Gonzalez is stepping down. Mr. Cummins said "The bottom line is he wasn't able to do his job anymore so it's a good move and it may be overdue but better now than never." He further indicated keeping Gonzales on was hurting the justice department. "The only satisfaction I feel is knowing now they can get some leadership in place that will be able to lead the department to do these important jobs they have," said Cummins. According to Cummins, Gonzales didn't seem willing to push back against the white house and says he ended up paying a tremendous personal price for that. Cummins said "I'm sure he's a good man and good father and good husband. He made some serious mistakes and did some things that are frankly pretty dishonorable trying to manage this problem when really just telling the truth would have been simplest thing to do and it would have put an end to it long ago." In the past year it has been a revolving door at the US attorney's office in Little Rock. Tim Griffin replaced Cummins on an interim basis, but then resigned in June. Now Jane Duke has taken the reigns. Congressman Boozman submitted three names to the white house in March for a permanent replacement, but no decision has been made.

News on *Nightside* – September 24, 2007

Christina Munoz reported that a heated reaction tonight after the President of Iran spoke at Columbia University in New York City. Protestors packed the streets surrounding the school while the controversial leader was on stage condemning him for his stance on Israel and Iran's alleged pursuit of nuclear weapons and support for terrorism. Inside an academic crowd struggled to get answers out of President Mahmoud Ahmadinejad, who in the past denied that the holocaust even existed. He told the crowd that he doesn't deny the holocaust took place but thinks more research should be done on the subject. In response to a question about how Iran treats homosexuals? He said in Iran there are none.

VIII. SPIRIT AND LEISURE (Interior)

News on *Daybreak* – April 26, 2007

Heather Crawford reported that Arkansas is known as a hunter's paradise - from ducking hunting to deer hunting but this year there's a new sport - alligator hunting. Channel seven's Heather Crawford participated in an alligator outing today and joins us now with more. A lot of people don't realize that alligators are actually native to Arkansas and the population is now stable enough that this fall a select few will get the chance to participate in the first modern day gator hunt in Arkansas. In the dark of the night we embark with the game and fish commission on an alligator hunt. Using spotlights to scan the water's surface we search for red eyes in Bois d 'Arc {bo-dark} lake in Hempstead County. One hour later - with the help of a snare - our wildlife experts catch just what they are looking for - a nearly 200 pound gator. "The gator was probably 8 or 9 feet long. We missed an opportunity once. We got pretty close to him but the second he held real good. We were able to get him. He broke the pole but that's not real unusual." It's illegal to shoot an unrestrained alligator. Hunters have to use either a harpoon or snare to capture the gator and would then kill it with a shot gun on bang stick but in this case the game and fish drags this alligator back to shore. He's tied and taped up so he can be safely measured and tagged. "Eight foot two inches, four foot and a male. We measure from the tip of his snout to the front of his vent" Now it's time to release him back into the wild. He makes his way back into the water and disappears. Come this September he will be fair game for 40 Arkansans who have received gator hunting permits. "It will be a lot of fun. It will be different. There's been no legal alligators taken in Arkansas so I think it will be fun to be one of the first." The alligator hunt will take place the last two weekends of September in southwest and southeast Arkansas. Each hunter is only allowed to harvest one gator that is at least four feet long. Hunters will be required to attend a orientation and training seminar beforehand. You can see more of the gator hunt by going to katv.com and looking under latest video.

Amanda Manatt reported on a south Arkansas tradition for 31-years now. Folks have flocked to Hope for its world-famous watermelon festival. It's a nice, pink, red-meated hope watermelon and it's nearly impossible to resist. Natives say that's because a little bit extra goes into growing a watermelon from hope. Mark Keith with the Hope Chamber of Commerce said "Sandy soil, a collective history of watermelon growing, over a hundred years of that, and a little special magic in the watermelon." It's no wonder Hempstead County is home to the world's biggest watermelon -- a whopping 268-pounds. In fact, in hope, the melon weighs right up there with the towns' two favorite sons. Melon farmer John Kirkpatrick said "Here's the thing about watermelon: when it comes to politics, you pick and choose. I understand that, but everybody agrees on a watermelon." John Kirkpatrick's been growing melons for decades. "I've been around watermelons ever since I was knee-high to a grasshopper," and he's got plenty of watermelon wisdom to share. Not quite that hungry? You can try tossing a hillbilly horseshoe, browse the crafts, or practice the time-honored tradition of spitting out seeds. Whatever you do, organizers say the 31st hope watermelon festival won't disappoint. More than 30-thousand people are expected to take part in the fun. The festival runs through tomorrow afternoon.

News Sunday *Nightside* at 10pm – September 23, 2007

Jessica Dean reported that one of the journalists who covered the Central High desegregation crisis is back in Little Rock tonight. Sander Vanocur says it was only after the fact, he realized how pivotal

the media coverage was in the fight for civil rights. Some people remember Sander Vanocur from his years as a political correspondent for both NBC and ABC news. He provided political commentary here on Channel 7. But before that part of his career, Vanocur spent the better part of a year in Little Rock, covering the desegregation crisis at Central High School. "This is the place that set off, I think, I don't want to get teary eyed about it, the change in civil rights in the country" In 1957, television news was still relatively new, but Vanocur says it played a pivotal role in broadcasting the sobering images across the country "You could not avoid them, they gripped our imagination, for better, for worse." Looking back 50 years, Vanocur says those images served as a catalyst-setting the stage for Dr. Martin Luther King and the fight for civil rights. "Now all these years later it seems to me that's exactly what happened, but I hate to disappoint you, I didn't think those deep thoughts at the time." Now, Sander Vanocur is back in Little Rock for a 50th anniversary he says he would not have missed. "Maybe I want to catch up and maybe I want to say thanks to the city that sort of launched my career-it means a great deal to me." Vanocur will speak tomorrow during a private event at the governor's mansion.

IX. TRANSPORTATION AND ENERGY

Heather Crawford reported new kind of subdivision will soon be built in Little Rock. It's the first of its kind in Arkansas where all of the homes will use solar power. A lot of people complain about their high energy bills these days but using solar power can help save you a lot of money, and this new solar subdivision is being called by some the wave of the future. Bill Ball knows first hand just how much money you can save by using solar power. His home - with solar panels on the roof - is 3200 square feet and guess how much his Entergy bills are? "\$16, \$20 for a large home. in August the worst bills we've had have bumped up to \$50 or \$60 but we may only have that for one month and then we'll have a lot of them that are \$20, \$25." Bill is now developing a subdivision near his solar powered home in little rock called Woodglen Park. The 35 home neighborhood is being built near Murray Lock and Dam and all the houses will be required to produce at least 50 percent of the electricity they use. "The whole idea is to use it for what it is but also as a training experience for builders because the way we're building these homes is much different. They are much more energy efficient than an average, even well-built home". Bill expects to break ground on the first home in the solar subdivision in the next 30 to 60 days.

Kristin Fisher reported that as the recovery effort continues in Minnesota - officials in Arkansas are changing plans to keep our bridges safe. This morning the Arkansas Highway and Transportation Department announced it will be increasing bridge inspections starting next week. Yesterday the highway department said it was business as usual. They were satisfied with the current inspection standards, but today...a very different story. This is the Minnesota Bridge before it buckled on Wednesday. Now take a look at this Arkansas Bridge on us 65 in Clinton. The similarities are striking. Both are deck truss bridges and starting Monday the highway department will be inspecting every bridge with the same design in the state. Randy Ort of AHTD said "We have identified 11 bridges in the state of Arkansas that are of a similar design to the one that failed in Minnesota and we decided that next week we will reevaluate those bridges." The Clinton Bridge is not classified as structurally deficient, but many of the other deck truss bridges in the state fall in the same category as the fated Minnesota bridge. So what does it mean if a bridge is indeed structurally deficient and just how dangerous are they? Structurally deficient does not mean that that bridge is in any way unsafe. It does not mean that the structural integrity of that bridge has been compromised. It simply means that the inspectors has noted some sort of deterioration that may not be normal. Meanwhile governor Mike Beebe is calling into question the money going into Iraqi infrastructure instead of our own. Beebe said "I understand we've got an obligation in various places but I think our first obligation is to the people of America."

Beth Hunt reported that a five year old boy is dead and his cousin seriously injured after their all-terrain vehicle crashed into heavy equipment in Washington County. It happened in Springdale. Authorities say Ethan Smith was sitting on his cousin's lap on a parked ATV when the boy grabbed the gear shift and the vehicle lunged forward. The ATV crashed into a trackhoe and the two were thrown off and hit the equipment. The boy and his cousin -- 32-year-old Tony Cardarelli -- were taken to a Fayetteville hospital, where the boy died. Cardarelli is being treated for a head injury from the accident.

Pamela Smith reported that a North Little Rock woman who lost both of her sons to violence is reaching out to other crime victims. Zena Cooper's sons, Marcus Cooper and Cortez Mallet were gunned down less than a year apart. Since that time she's been on a mission to try to stop the senseless killings. She's formed an allegiance with other mothers whose son's shared a similar fate... and many of them were so concerned about the recent spike in violence, they stopped by the channel seven studios to issue a public plea. Cooper says while the pain of losing children never gets any easier she at least hopes to share her story to prevent other families from experiencing what she and these mothers have. She talked about the last few moments of her youngest son, Marcus' life after learning he'd been shot in the chest. "I say baby pray, that's what I told my son. He just held his thumb up and I thought maybe he was telling me it was going to be alright, that he was praying, it was going to be okay, but he didn't make it. It was devastating. It was the last thing I was expecting, it was like 3-4 months. I was in shock. I wasn't expecting them to say he wasn't going to make it. I want the people to pray for our kids and my other son, he's going back to Iraq and I want people to pray for the world, period." White's son is 23-year-old James Michael Gillespie who died in October 2006. Zena Cooper is helping families like Joanne White learn to cope and she's doing it in honor of her two sons. We'll tell you about the special project next weekend.

Anne Pressly reported that search parties in Perry county are actively looking for an elderly man missing since this morning. 85-year-old John Thompson was last spotted when he left for his daily walk at about 6-am and he hasn't been seen or heard from since. Several law enforcement agencies have been searching for Thompson both on the ground and in the air since early afternoon. People on 4-wheelers have been scouring the area as the state police helicopter hovers over Perry county searching for any sign of the missing man. Thompson lives on a youth ranch near the tiny town of Hollis. Those who know Thompson say he suffers from dementia and fear for his health. Thomspson is 5-9 and about 160-pounds. He was last seen wearing khaki pants, a golf shirt, and glasses.

Heather Crawford reported Tuesday's ceremony to commemorate the desegregation of Little Rock's Central High School is the first time the nine black students involved have all spoken publicly together since 1957. They each shared their own unique perspective of how far we've come and how far we have to go. With a police escort the Little Rock Nine arrived at Central High in a limousine. Royal treatment they certainly did not receive 50 years ago. Melba Pattilo Bealssaid "It means everything because it's confirmation of the kinds of movements we made were correct and it's a confirmation little rock as a body and community has grown tremendously over the last 50 years." One by one each of the little rock nine reflected on the central high crisis. Ernest Green said "We were nine teenagers. We thought this was a place that would accept us, that we would belong. We saw it as a building that offered opportunities and options for us and you know what 50 years later I think we were right." What happened at Central High is a story Carlotta Walls Lanier hopes no one will ever forget and she urged everyone to learn about the past. "There are a lot of barriers out there but you can overcome that. You can overcome adversity if you know you are doing the right thing. We knew we were doing the right thing." The Little Rock Nine are spread out all over the country, one even lives in Europe. Only three currently live in Little Rock.

FCC Schedule for Closed-Captioning Requirements

The following phase-in schedule applies to the captioning and broadcast of all new programming. It is measured on a calendar-quarter basis and a 20-hour broadcast day, as programming between 2am and 6am does not have to be captioned.

- Between January 1, 2000, and December 31, 2001, program distributors must provide at least 450 hours of captioned programming per calendar quarter, which is approximately five hours per day. If the program distributor provides less than 450 hours of new programming, then 95 percent of its new programming must be captioned.
- Between January 1, 2002, and December 31, 2003, program distributors must provide at least 900 hours of captioned video programming per calendar quarter, or 10 hours per day. If the programming distributor provides less than 900 hours of new programming, then 95 percent of its new programming must be captioned.
- Between January 1, 2004, and December 31, 2005, program distributors must provide at least an average of 1,350 hours of captioned video programming per calendar quarter, or 15 hours per day. If the program distributor provides less than 1,350 hours of new programming, then 95 percent of its new programming must be captioned.
- **As of January 1, 2006, and thereafter, 100 percent of the program distributors' new programming must be captioned.**
