RE: Quarterly Children's Programming Reports (FCC Form 398)

for Telemundo Stations

As a reminder, each station must complete and submit electronically its children's programming report on FCC Form 398 for the second quarter of 2015 by July 10, 2015.

Please note that you need to use the FCC Server Version to file Form 398 -- see link below:

Because you are now required to provide your station's Facility ID Number along with FCC Registration Number and Password upon accessing the Form 398, we are no longer able to provide a template of the form. However, you are now able to prefill information from the most recently-filed quarter. For this and future quarters, we will be attaching a Word version of the programming information from which you can cut and paste to your report, as needed. If you pre-fill the report with the prior quarter's information, take special care to

- (i) use the drop-down menu to update it to the correct quarter or the last quarter's report will be overwritten, and
- (ii) update any information that has changed since the prior quarter.

Each station must check its own records to confirm what programming actually aired on the station. Each station likewise should confirm that any information provided herein applies to its circumstances before including it on the FCC Form 398. Please note that to the extent there are preemptions for breaking news, they do not require a preemption box. Rather, these preempted programs should be counted as if they had actually aired. However, it is advisable to note the fact of the breaking news preemption (including program, date and reason for breaking news preemption) in response to Question No. 17.

Preemption notations, based solely on information for the network's programming, follow the description of each show and may be used to complete the station's preemption report. The Telemundo Network reports the following preemptions and program reschedulings for this quarter:

Central and Mountain Time Zone affiliates and stations should note the following:

- All the times on the attached document are Eastern and Pacific Time Zones only, which will require stations in other time zones to adjust the times noted in this report accordingly. Also, if Core Programming times are adjusted, the upcoming programming times in Block 14 under "Other Matters" will likely require adjustment as well.
- Programming aired on the station other than between 7 a.m. and 10 p.m. local time should not be listed as core.

After the report is filed, it will be automatically uploaded to the station's online public inspection file on the FCC's website. You should keep paper copies of both the report and the FCC filing confirmation for your files. In connection with license renewal applications, stations are required to certify that Forms 398 were filed in a timely manner; a copy of the filing confirmation serves as proof of timely filing if the FCC's records are not complete. These documents are also essential to prove timely filing in the event you inadvertently overwrite a previously-filed report.
