Quarterly Issues and Programming Narrative – 3rd Quarter 2008

Programming addressing major issues in 3rd Quarter 2008 includes the following:

1) **Crime and Community Safety**

KEZI+ contributed 902 announcements for Crime and Community Safety ranging from foster care issues to building stronger, safer families and homes, plus weekly Kids In Crisis and Crimestoppers news franchise reports and promotions focused on crime prevention and fugitive capture in news programs and on kezi.com.

2) **Fuel**

KEZI+ contributed no announcements towards the issue.

3) **Traffic / Transportation / Environmental Planning**

KEZI+ contributed 780 announcements in this category focused mainly on environmental planning through kids inventions and environmental protection message as well as, numerous news packages highlight traffic, construction, transportation and environmental impact stories facing our viewers.

4) **Government**

KEZI+ contributed no announcements in this category.

5) **Land Use / Community Growth**

KEZI contributed 347 announcements pertaining to the community issue of Land Use and Growth. KEZI also produced several news stories and online information dealing with university and municipal land use issues as well as, community growth and housing industry problems curbing growth in our viewing area.
