- (1) *Cheap Eats*: In these tough economic times, folks are looking for a way to save money. To assist, each week Guy Hagi & other special guests introduce our viewers to local eateries where they can get great food at affordable prices. Cheap Eats airs every Wednesday during the 6:30PM and 9:00PM news.
- (2) *Hi-Five*: This Segment recognizes Hawaii's local athlete of the week for their high school or collegiate athletic accomplishments. Hi-Five airs every Tuesday during the 6:30PM and 9:00PM news and on Wednesday's Sunrise at 8:00PM.
- (3) *Pacific Pulse*: This segment covers happenings in the ocean that surrounds us. The ocean that provides us with seafood, recreation, transportation, and adventure is vital to an island state like Hawaii. Each week Guy Hagi interviews notable ocean experts that remind us how important this rich and vital resource is. Pacific Pulse airs every Thursday during the 6:30PM news and on Friday's Sunrise at 8:00PM.

Editorials ("Think About It...")

General Manager John Fink prepares, writes, and presents editorials for airing on KFVE. During the quarter, two editorials were aired each week, each of which airs twice during the given week. The first editorial airs within KFVE newscasts on Monday, 9-9:30 PM and on Tuesday, 6:30-7 PM, and the second weekly editorial airs within newscasts on Thursday 9-9:30 PM and Friday, 6:30-7 PM. The editorials are typically 75-90 seconds in length.

IT SEEMS WE NOW SEE MORE FOCUS ON STREET SLEEPERS AS THE HOMELESS HAVE MIGRATED FROM OAHU'S LEEWARD COAST BEACHES TO IN-YOUR-FACE SITES LIKE AROUND THE UH MEDICAL SCHOOL IN KAKAAKO, DOWNTOWN, AND IN THAT WELL-KNOWN VISITOR REALM, WAIKIKI. WHILE THERE IS NO SINGLE, SIMPLE, ALL-PURPOSE SOLUTION TO THE PROBLEM OF ECONOMIC WOES SUBSTANCE ABUSE AND/OR MENTAL HEALTH PROBLEMS WHICH MAY LEAD TO HOMELESSNESS, WE NEED TO KEEP THE PRESSURE ON ELECTED OFFICIALS TO PROVIDE ANSWERS AND MORE COUNSELING AND OTHER OPTIONS TO HELP MANY OF THESE PEOPLE GET BACK ON THEIR FEET AND OUT OF THE STREETS. THE STATE OF UTAH ACTUALLY PROVIDES HOUSING FOR HOMELESS PEOPLE, PREFERRING THOSE COSTS TO THE GOVERNMENT COSTS OF TREATING HOMELESSNESS, AND APPARENTLY IT'S WORKING TO GREATLY REDUCE UTAH'S HOMELESS ISSUE. ARE WE LOOKING AT ALL OF THE TESTED OPTIONS THAT HAVE WORKED ELSEWHERE? IS THERE STRONG NETWORKING BETWEEN CITIES, STATES, AND SOCIAL ENTITIES NATIONWIDE OR WORLDWIDE TO HELP MUNICIPALITIES BETTER HANDLE THIS BURGEONING PROBLEM? THE CITY OF HONOLULU AND THE STATE OF HAWAII REACHED A SEEMINGLY LANDMARK AGREEMENT LAST YEAR TO CREATE A PUBLIC MEMORIAL BEACH AT THE NATATORIUM SITE, WHILE THEY WOULD ALSO PRESERVE THE ARCHWAY AND HOPEFULLY DRAW EVEN MORE ATTENTION TO ITS WORLD WAR I HERITAGE. DONE; CASE CLOSED, RESOLUTION REACHED... BUT NOT SO FAST. PRESERVATIONISTS INSIST THAT FUNDING CAN BE RAISED TO REVIVE THE NATATORIUM WITH ITS SALT WATER POOL AND GRANDSTANDS. ESTIMATES ON THOSE COSTS RUN FROM \$50-MILLION TO \$70-MILLION. IT'S HARD TO BELIEVE THOSE FUNDS CAN REALISTICALLY BE FOUND OR RAISED AS THE STRUCTURAL ENTITY DEGRADES AND BECOMES A BIGGER SAFETY HAZARD, NOT TO MENTION UNUSABLE BY ANYBODY. EFFORTS AT RESTORATION OF THE STRUCTURE BY PRESERVATIONISTS BEGAN IN EARNEST IN 1986, ALMOST 30-YEARS AGO, AND YET HERE WE ARE TODAY WITH A NICE, NEW DESIGNATION, BUT STILL NO APPARENT ACTIONS ABOUT TO BE TAKEN. WE SHOULD MOVE FORWARD TO SAVE WHAT IS SALVAGEABLE, BETTER EDUCATE AND INFORM THE PUBLIC WHAT THIS 87-YEAR OLD STRUCTURE REPRESENTS, AND LET THE BEACH BECOME A USEFUL REMEMBRANCE OF HAWAII'S WORLD WAR I FIGHTERS.
