## **Sponsorships and Community Involvement 4th Quarter, 2019**

*Go Pink ATX* – Mix 94.7 and Majic 95.5 promoted Going Pink during Breast Cancer Awareness Month. Businesses & organizations shared what they were doing, such as Pink Events or Pink Purchases, to beat breast cancer in the month of October. And the community learned about these special fundraisers happening in and around Austin in support of the fight against breast cancer on a dedicated website. The effort benefitted the Breast Cancer Resource Center of Central Texas.

*Spectrum Community Impact Day* – Hot 95.9 teamed up with Spectrum to support their Community Impact Day, committed to improving communities and impacting lives where their customers and employees live and work. The first 250 families received a free Safe & Healthy Home Kit.

*Whataburger Whata-Miracle Maker Holiday Fundraiser* – Mix 94.7 partnered with Whataburger to promote the Whata-Miracle Maker Holiday Fundraiser.
