January 13, 2020	Family Minute (1 min. program – airs @ 10:20 am & 11:35 pm M-F)	Host & family expert Dr. Tim Kimmel identifies four things our kids need in their lives to form deep convictions about: family, friends, faith, and freedom... and to prevent selfishness.
January 22, 2020	“	Host & family expert Dr. Tim Kimmel discusses single parenting. Their job is never-ending and their work is never done. Day after day they carry the load...alone. Dr. Kimmel gives tips regarding how to help single moms and dads.
February 6, 2020	“	Host & family expert Dr. Tim Kimmel gives suggestions on about how to balance work and family life.
February 24, 2020	“	Host & family expert Dr. Tim Kimmel discusses recent research cited in the Wall Street Journal that says our children would be much happier if we didn't give them everything they wanted. He cites a few ways to give your children less.
March 11, 2020	“	Host & family expert Dr. Tim Kimmel shares information about the dangers of complaining to your kids about your spouse. When you speak unkind words about your spouse you are creating a negative image of your spouse to your kids.

OVERCOMING OBSTACLES
A sampling of programs from the 1st Quarter of 2020

Air Date	Program	Subject
January 16, 2020	Diamonds in the Dust (1 min program airs @ 2:20 am & 1:35 pm M-F)	Host Joni Eareckson Tada shares the story of how she felt when she first came home from the hospital after the accident that left her a paraplegic. She felt helpless, but also felt loved by her family. She encourages listeners to show love and support to family and friends in the way she felt loved and supported.
February 7, 2020	“	Host Joni Eareckson Tada describes a boy named Puumi, a 13-year-old boy in Thailand with cerebral palsy. In Thailand, Puumi’s disability is considered shameful; he was abandoned when he was only a baby. Joni describes how the Wheels for the World team of her organization serves children with disabilities, just like Puumi.
February 17, 2020	“	Joni Eareckson Tada talks about how she started off hating her wheelchair, but soon grew to appreciate the freedom it allowed her. She encourages support of the Wheels for the World campaign so that others can have the same freedom.
March 2, 2020	“	Host Joni Eareckson Tada shares about her friend Terry who the mother of Holly, a 21-year-old girl with autism. For years, Holly enjoyed her special education classes in public school, but now that she’s an adult, she’s no longer eligible for those classes. Joni shares about a program that is allowing adults with autism to receive the care and stimulation they need.
March 22, 2020	“	Joni Eareckson Tada shares how her friend Michelle is a fabulous hairdresser who decided to share her talents at their Joni and Friends Family Retreat. She brought her salon stuff and set everything up on the porch of a cabin, and gave haircuts, manicures, hair coloring. The program encourages use of people’s skills to serve the disabled.

January 17, 2020	Just a Thought w/ Ravi Zacharias (1 min. program airs @ 12:35 pm M-F)	Ravi Zacharias recounts the story of Oscar Wilde and his recognition of the emptiness of his life which was lived purely for pleasure's sake. Ravi ends today's Thought with a warning regarding pain and pleasure.
February 10, 2020	“	Our human condition cannot be diagnosed fully through the science of Psychology. Today on Just A Thought Ravi Zacharias proscribes the application of Theology in determining the source of the illness of humanity.
February 20, 2020	“	In this edition, speaker Ravi Zacharias makes a stark statement about the influence of the philosophers in Nazi Germany and the creation of the gas chambers of the concentration camps.
March 2, 2020	“	Ravi Zacharias talks about famous atheist Richard Dawkins who once wrote that he wondered whether religious thought should even be allowed on a college campus anymore. This type of thinking shows that atheism though claiming to be the most tolerant of belief systems may actually be the most intolerant. On today's Thought Ravi Zacharias proceeds to give examples of how the ultimate outworking of this exclusionary thinking has manifested itself in past governments.
March 10, 2020	“	Ravi Zacharias describes his challenge to eastern religious leaders to explain the origin of evil and that they are unable to give a satisfactory answer.
