January 21, 2019	Money Wise Minute (:60 program airs 5:35 pm M-F)	Host Rob West discusses promissory notes and how Americans can live up to them.
February 5, 2019	“	Host Rob West gives wisdom on financial margin and not living paycheck to paycheck.
February 20, 2019	“	Host Rob West offers advice on how to get out of your routine to make better financial decisions.
Mach 7, 2019	“	Host Rob West talks about the history of the game Monopoly and how it applies to our lives these days.

Air Date	Program	Subject
January 24, 2019	Family Life Blended (1 min. program – airs @ 10:20 am M-F)	Host Ron Deal discusses what happens how a stepparent may resent the time their spouse gives to their children from their first marriage... or the kids may feel jealous of the time their parent gives to the stepparent. The issue here is insecurity. So you don’t feel the need to compete remind yourself God provides us with an endless amount of love.
February 13, 2019	“	Host Ron Deal answers a person who says that they don’t want to date a single parent. Knowing what you want is an important aspect of wise dating that every single person should consider.
February 28, 2019	“	Host Ron Deal discusses what happens when a dad and stepdad team up... Kids win—that’s what happens.

March 7, 2019	“	Host Ron Deal presents this topic: Many issues can undermine a stepfamily marriage like disagreements about co-parenting, financial issues, or ongoing conflict between bitter ex-partners. If your marriage isn't unified these issues can divide you. So, to protect your marriage, communicate a lot. Resist blaming each other or letting your frustration spill out on the children. If co-parenting isn't going well, consult with a family mediator or therapist.
March 22, 2019	“	Host Ron Deal presents this topic: When single a parent get married they want their children to feel connected to their stepparent but some don't see it happening. Some stepfamily members take longer to connect. Perseverance and encouragement goes a long way. Advice is to attend to the marriage and the children, and time will work things out.

January 5, 2019	Diamonds in the Dust (1 min program airs @ 1:35 pm M-F)	Host Joni Eareckson Tada shares the story of a <i>Wheels for the World</i> outreach in Poland, where they met Grazina who hadn't been out of her room in seven years. She wasn't able to walk and didn't have a wheelchair and so she languished by her window, watching the world go by. This all changed when she was given a wheelchair!
January 30, 2019	“	Host Joni Eareckson Tada describes a girl named Celia who lives in Africa with her child, Akua who is a little girl with significant brain damage. For years, Celia carried around her daughter, and her back was getting tired—but her heart was also heavy. It's so hard raising a disabled child in Africa. But that all changed when the <i>Wheels for the World</i> team fitted little Akua to her first wheelchair.

February 23, 2019	“	Joni Eareckson Tada talks about how special needs families can find that attending church can be a challenge. Take Becky, and her son Chris who has autism. One Sunday, in the middle of the sermon, Chris let out a scream—it was so loud, the pastor lost his train of thought! Embarrassed and crying, Becky ushered her son out of the church and into the car. But what she thought was a disaster was used to bring awareness. It became clear to everyone: this mother needed help. And now, Becky’s church has classes for special needs kids and “Family Nights,” where parents bring their children to events, and nobody cares how noisy it gets. That awful incident resulted in so much good.
March 20, 2019	“	Host Joni welcomes two guests who discuss World Down Syndrome Day.
March 26, 2019	“	Joni Erickson Tada talks about how Joni and Friends has been talking about how they’re working to solve the mobility crisis through nationwide wheelchair collection events. This included a wheelchair drive at their Joni and Friends Headquarters on Friday, March 29th! The program details how everyone in the community can get involved in collecting wheelchairs!

January 15, 2019	Just a Thought w/ Ravi Zacharias (1 min. program airs @ 12:35 pm M-F)	The concept of morality—our sense of right and wrong—is intrinsic to human nature. On today's Just A Thought, Ravi Zacharias suggests that our morality reveals evidence for the existence of God.
February 11, 2019	“	In this edition, Ravi Zacharias describes how more and more of his interactions of faith and discourse have been accompanied by anger. It sometimes progresses to the point where equitable discussion and amicable conversation does not seem possible.

February 25, 2019	“	Ravi Zacharias had a discussion with a young man whose primary goal in life was to be number one. The young man's question to Ravi was how could he be consistent and diligent in his pursuit of his goal. Listen to today's Thought as Ravi redirects the man to take his focus off of human aspiration and discover God's purpose for his life.
March 13, 2019	“	In this edition, Ravi Zacharias describes the birth of postmodernism which started as a literary critic and then blossomed into an entire worldview.
March 25, 2019	“	Ravi Zacharias describes his challenge to atheists to give a definition of what is good or morally right. He then comments on the state of our society during this time where naturalism, secularism, materialism, and relativism are the worldviews with the most influence.
