| July 22, 2019 | Money Wise Minute (:60 program airs 5:35 pm M-F) | Host Rob West shares how investing in real estate can be a great way to build wealth, but the 2008 crash showed that it can also be a great way to lose your shirt. Rob says there is a way for real estate to continue to be a solid investment, but you have to do it right. |
| August 12, 2019 | “ | Host Rob West talks about how setting up an Emergency Savings Fund is critical to your financial success, but it's easier said than done. Rob West shares a few ways to make it happen, and talks about some of the things people often do that tend to fail. |
| August 24, 2019 | “ | Monday is the most common day to have a heart attack. One of the factors cited by some heart attack survivors was that they hate their jobs. Host Rob West says it's never too late to ask God if He might have a different plan for your skills and interests. |
| September 11, 2019 | “ | There are plenty of reasons people give for not budgeting, and host Rob West has heard them all. He debunks them and explains why everyone needs a budget (also known as a spending plan) no matter how much or how little they have. |

| July 16, 2019 | “ | Host Ron Deal discusses how decisions and routines can be disrupted when one parent gets remarried. He says, good co-parenting over time requires change. You may not like it, but for your kids’ sake, adapt and adjust. |
| August 22, 2019 | “ | Host Ron Deal discusses being honest with money issues regarding stepchildren, such as when they might discover that their spouse has loaned money to an adult child without their knowledge. There’s no room for secrets or emotional games in blended families, especially between spouses. |
| September 12, 2019 | “ | Host Ron Deal Every shares how every stepfamily has a loss narrative just below the surface that impacts and influences every aspect of the family. For a child whose parent died, for example, embracing a stepparent can feel like burying their parent again. Sadness impacts bonding. Understanding this helps you listen better, have more patience, and support those you care about. |
| September 25, 2019 | “ | Host Ron Deal describes how when a parent and stepparent spend time together children sometimes feel pushed aside. This naturally puts the biological parent in the middle. That’s a big difference between biological families and blended families. In either situation it is important to extend grace and apply patience to relationships. |
