WALZ FM airs seven local newscasts per day Monday through Friday at 5:30am, 6:30am, 7:07am, 8:07am, 11:30am, 12:30pm, 4:30pm and 5:30pm featuring local and regional news and important information for our listeners. WQDY FM also airs national news at the top of the hour 5am to 6pm Monday through Friday, 6am to 1pm Saturday and Sunday.

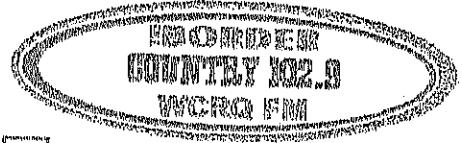
WALZ FM airs "Community Clip Board", an updated daily feature promoting local area community fundraisers, events and cancellations at 7:45am, 12:45pm and 4:45pm Monday through Friday and 7:45am and 12:45pm Saturday and Sunday.

Additionally, WALZ FM airs free public service announcements for area non-profit organizations in excess of one hundred minutes per week, and often teams for live local broadcast of fundraising and awareness events.

WQDY / WALZ partner with Healthy Acadia, a local non Profit, for our Turkey A Thon. This annual event benefits all the food pantries in Washington County. We promote the event with promos during the month of September. We then broadcast live for 20 hours asking people to come donate \$12 for a turkey. We have volunteers stationed at 7 different locations where people can donate. All proceeds goes to our local food pantries to help them supply a healthy meal on the holiday tables of people living in Washington County.

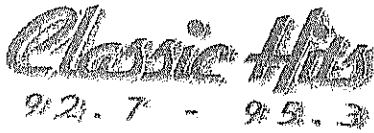

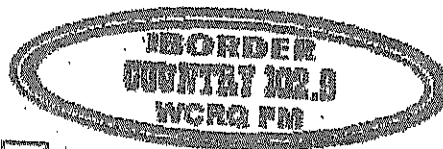

I want to make sure people understand that Down East Hospice Volunteers do NOT provide any nursing care. We also do NOT handle medications, ever. Hospice nurses take care of medical needs.

Hospice clients appreciate your company. However, since we are state licensed, you can't just raise your hand and become a hospice volunteer.

The training is mandatory.

No trained volunteer will be asked to take on a volunteer situation that the volunteer is uncomfortable with.

DEHV is flexible and I give each volunteer an opportunity to turn down an assignment. Actually, this hardly ever happens.

Hospice families in our communities depend on our volunteers for companionship, possibly running a couple of errands.

Some volunteers will offer to walk the hospice client's dog. At the end of the training, each volunteers get the chance to list things they are comfortable doing and things they prefer not to do. This list is confidential and I'm the only one who has access.

A hospice volunteer will sit with their hospice client and keep them company. Some clients like to be read to, play cards or games, watch their favorite TV shows with some company. Often, you will listen to life stories and reminisce along with your volunteer.

Hospice volunteers are giving the caregivers respite time for what ever they could use that time for. If someone is a sincere listener and wants to become a hospice volunteer, they are 90% on their way.

I usually meet the hospice client and his or her caregivers before bringing in a hospice volunteer. Then I decide what volunteer may fit their needs and how close do they live to the hospice client. I try not to send our hospice volunteers too far from home.

We have hospice clients of all ages with many different terminal diagnosis. In 2021 (so far) our clients have ranged from mid 60's to early 90's. We have had clients in their 30's and younger in the past.

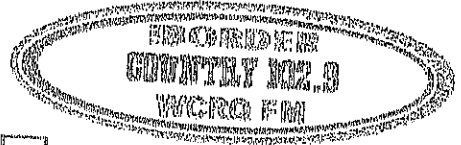


