Dear Healthcare Administrator,

Federal Regulation 47CFR 15.242 (a) (1) requires KRXI-TV in Reno, to notify you of a change in our regular operation that could interfere, however unlikely, with the operation of certain legacy biomedical equipment.

- The Fox 11 KRXI-TV Digital Signal is operating on Radiofrequency UHF Channel 44 at 650 to 656 Megahertz
- This television broadcast signal for KRXI-TV has been present 24/7 since 2002.
- The Station currently operates at a power level of 500,000 Watts of Effective Radiated Power, abbreviated ERP.
- In year 2002 when the Station signed on the air, the licensed power level was 1,000,000 Watts, ERP.
- The Station desires to return to a similar power level of 950,000 Watts, ERP.
- We desire to accomplish this change by April 2nd 2015
- The KRXI antenna is located on top of Peavine Peak.
- The antenna is about 114 feet above ground on a tower, 3,700 feet above and 7 Miles North West from St. Mary's Hospital.
- A significant portion of the radiant energy will pass above all facilities, as it has since year 2002.
- All other Hospitals are located at greater distance away from the antenna, even less susceptible to interference.
- In 2002, When KRXI-TV started Digital Operation the Station conducted a notification to healthcare facilities and received no complaints.

KRXI-TV will cooperate with health care facilities giving reasonable opportunity to resolve any interference problems caused by the change in our operating power. If there are any questions or concerns please contact me.
