Description: Pennsylvania Fire Commissioner Tim Solobay discussed a number of issues of interest and importance to firefighters, government officials, and area residents. The commissioner discussed in great detail the dwindling number of volunteer firefighters across the state. Solobay says in the mid-70s there were more than three-hundred-thousand volunteers across the state and now there are only about 50-thousand. He referenced two state reports, the Senate Resolution 60 Report and the General Assembly's Legislative Budget and Finance Committee's resolution 148 report, which focused on problems of the volunteer fire service in Pennsylvania. Solobay discussed the findings of these two reports. He said the volunteer fire service in Pennsylvania is at a critical juncture. The commissioner said the volunteer system faces significant challenges in overcoming a growing lack of both human and financial resources. Solobay cited skyrocketing costs of fire equipment which has increased much faster than the rate of inflation and cost of living. He said protective clothing for a firefighter has risen to about three-thousand dollars per fireman. Breathing apparatus used to enter burning buildings has increased to about 75-hundred dollars. Fire-engines cost over a half-million dollars and ladder trucks about one-million. He pointed to the over 150-hours for essential basic new firefighter training as another reason people are not volunteering.

Description: The Executive Director of the Westmoreland County Airport Authority, Gabe Monzo, answered questions about the authority and the two public county airports it operates, Arnold Palmer Regional Airport near Latrobe and the Rostraver Airport in Rostraver Township. Mr. Monzo gave information on the mission and history of the authority and both airports. He discussed the economic impact of the airports, particularly the Palmer Airport which offers daily scheduled air service via Spirit Airlines operating full size airliners offering seating for 140 to 170 passengers. The airport is also a center for corporate jet operators which offer business jet and charter service all over the world. The director said a recent economic impact study showed the airport added 94-million dollars to the economy before Spirit and 199-million since Spirit has been operating. Monzo explained expansion plans for the facility. He also said the airport authority is planning a two-day airshow for May 21st and 22nd with the feature act being the Canadian Air Force Snowbirds demonstration team.

Ms. Cerilli was elected to her first political position as a member of the three-member Board of County Commissioners last year and took office in January. She has her B.A. and M.A in business administration and has just completed her Jurist Doctorate. She is also a former Miss Pennsylvania. She said it was during her reign as Miss Pennsylvania while doing her public service work she decided she wanted to run for public office and be of service to the public. We talked with Ms. Cerilli about what she considers to be the biggest problems facing Westmoreland County and county government. Cerilli is very concerned about the growing drug abuse problem in the area. She talked about the various agencies and departments under the control of the Commissioners. She explained how some agencies are pass-through agencies that are mandated by the state or federal government and just administered by the county. There are other "row" offices and the courts which the commissioners are responsible for funding but are also mandated by law.

Description: Our guest was the archivist for the Lincoln Highway Heritage Corridor who answered questions about the organization and the "Lincoln Highway", the nation's first coast to coast roadway. The mission of Lincoln Highway Heritage Corridor is to identify, conserve, promote, and interpret the cultural, historical, natural, recreational, and economic resources along the Lincoln Highway in Westmoreland and adjacent counties through which the highway passes. Our guest promoted several upcoming events sponsored by the organization, May 1st free admission to Lincoln Highway Experience Museum, June 4th a program "Dispelling the Myths", June 25th Inside Home Tour, and July 8th Indian Brand Motorcycle Tour. Poerschke discussed the history of the road. In the early 1900's when the automobile was in its infancy those that had cars found rural road conditions unsuitable for driving as they were primarily dirt paths connecting farmlands. A group of visionary businessmen formed the Lincoln Highway Association to spearhead the creation of a publically-funded road from New York City to San Francisco. When completed it stretched 3,389 miles across the country. In Pennsylvania much of the highway was constructed by improving and linking pre-existing roads and turnpikes. It was the focal point of the "Good Roads" movement which eventually led to the development of decent highways all over the nation. The creation of the Lincoln Highway had had a significant impact on how people traveled. It also had significant economic impact as filling stations, tourist cabins, motor courts, and restaurants lined the highways to serve travelers.

Description: Our guest was Westmoreland County's Director of Public Safety Roland "Bud" Mertz. Mr. Mertz traced his history from being a Greensburg firefighter from the time he was a teenager, a Greensburg Police Dispatcher, State Police Dispatcher, Deputy Director of the State's Department of Homeland Security and Pennsylvania Emergency Management Official before accepting the Westmoreland County position. The Westmoreland County Department of Public Safety is an umbrella agency responsible for a variety of agencies including 9-1-1, Emergency Management, Park Police, and others. He talked about the importance of the 9-1-1 center which operates 24 hours a day 365 days a year. He said 9-1-1 is the link between people who have emergency problems and the first responders (police, fire, ambulance) who are coming to render aid. He spoke of upgrades and improvements to the Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) system and countywide interoperable radio system that links all agencies with the center and one another. He explained the Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC), a committee of appointed volunteers, who have responsibility for looking at and helping recommend plans to respond to potential emergencies. The volunteer Hazardous Materials Response Team also operates under the direction of the Department of Public Safety.

Mr. Rigone oversees a number of planning, economic, and industrial development programs for various county agencies. Rigone explained the county comprehensive plan which he described as a guidance document for future growth. He answered questions about planning and land use. Rigone talked about various industrial development projects including the county's very successful eighteen industrial parks. He explained how his agencies market area development to create and maintain jobs. Rigone says Westmoreland County is strategically located for business within five-hundred miles of seventy per cent of the total U-S population. He talked about transportation planning and online maps of proposed projects. Rigone explained the status of the Laurel Valley transportation improvement program. The Laurel Valley project has been talked about since the 60s. The current proposal calls for widening and other improvements to existing roads to create a four lane highway from the intersection of Interstate-70 and the Pennsylvania Turnpike (I-76) to Route 30 near the Arnold Palmer Regional Airport.
