Since she is at the school and spends extensive time in the classroom with students, she discovers students which can be a good fit. This initiative has been great for students, who would have never been able to set inside the competitive world of broadcasting and a unique and dynamic resource in Red Wolf's recruiting efforts.

Latin Festival Oct. 8, 2021 Farm Fresh RI 9 AM to 3 PM. WKKB & WSKP produced a Latin Festival targeting the Hispanic community in the greater Providence community. As a part of the festival it had a job fair and many employment opportunities. WKKB also had a booth to recruit sales, marketing, street teamers, voice over artists and on air personalities. About a 1,000 attended. This is the 8th year for the event. Hundreds of commercials were run over Red Wolf's stations, as well as flyers & posters and social media posts.
