

The Wenatchee School District invites the public to provide input on its voting district proposal.

The School Board is a five-member elected body where all members are currently elected at large by voters within the school district boundary. The School Board determined the current at-large voting system may violate the Washington Voting Rights Act. To correct the potential violation, a proposal where four members would be required to reside in a specific voting district and be elected only by voters within that same voting district is being considered.

Input on the voting district proposal can be provided during a public hearing on June 14, 2022, at 6:00 pm, at the District Office located at 235 Sunset Ave., Wenatchee, Washington. Input can also be provided prior to the public hearing by submitting a written comment at the District Office or by email at white.k@wenatcheeschools.org
