ECONOMY/INFLATION

The Myrtle Beach area is now the #1 fastest growing area, with rent increases up 36% since before the pandemic. As the nation deals with rising inflation – affecting everything from food to gas prices – we focused on the impact this is having on our communities and industries. We’re also seeing impacts to other communities from workforce shortages and inflation issues.

FLOODING

In the past five years, our communities have dealt with a number of major weather events, from a historic 1,000-year flood in 2015 to several hurricanes like Matthew and Florence. While those events caused flooding, we’re also now seeing flooding after minor weather events. In some cases, development is to blame, in others it’s a lack of attention or resources to flood mitigation. We continue to be a voice for those in our community who are seeing flooding over and over again.

GROWTH AND DEVELOPMENT

Horry County is one of the fastest growing areas in the country. This quarter we saw a number of major developments along highways in our community. Residents are concerned that the roads are not able to handle the number of cars safely. We covered discussions about building moratoriums and how the growth puts a strain on resources in our community. It also leads to issues with stormwater drainage, which leads to flooding. As we build up more and more, places begin to see flooding that haven’t before. We are committed to covering the growth in our area and the challenges it presents to our communities.

PEE DEE CRIME

We have seen a drastic increase in crime in the Pee Dee. Sheriffs there tell us young people aren’t considering the consequences and have no consideration for the value of human life. We make sure we are able to cover not only the crimes, but the solutions being presented, and the impact to the families involved.
