Monday July 2, 2018

Issue: Greencard by Marriage

Program: El Show de Alex El Genio Lucas

Description: Attorney Jorge Rivera discussed the good, the bad, and the ugly of obtaining residency via marriage.

Wednesday July 4, 2018

Issue: Trump wants permission to lock up immigrant families indefinitely

Program: El Show de Alex El Genio Lucas

Description: After reversing course on its policy of separating families at the border Wednesday, the Trump administration officially presented its new plan Thursday: Just go back to detaining families together. Lawyers for the Justice Department asked a California federal judge Thursday to amend the decades-old legal agreement known as the “Flores settlement,” which stops the government from detaining minors for longer than 20 days in family detention facilities operated by the Department of Homeland Security. These changes would be required in order to hold kids and their families while their case winds through the nation’s incredibly backlogged immigration court system.

Thursday July 5, 2018

Issue: Become a permanent resident through your U.S. Citizen child

Program: El Show de Alex El Genio Lucas

Description: Children born in the U.S. can sponsor their parents for green card status. However, the child has to turn 21 to file an immigrant petition for his or her parents. At the same time, the child’s parents will need to meet all the requirements to get a green card in the U.S.

Monday July 9, 2018

Issue: When it comes to immigration advice, beware immigration fraud

Program: El Show de Alex El Genio Lucas

Description: Attorney Jorge Rivera gave 5 tips to avoid becoming the victim of immigration fraud: beware of false friends, beware exaggerated promises, beware insider connections, beware small details, beware unqualified legal advisors.

Wednesday July 11, 2018

Issue: A quiet change in US policy threatens immigrants who apply for a change in status

Program: El Show de Alex El Genio Lucas

Description: On June 28, USCIS announced that non-citizens who apply for a “benefit”—such as an extension or change of status, a green card, or citizenship—would be placed in deportation proceedings if that benefit is denied. For years, a criminal conviction has been required to be fast-tracked for deportation. Now, merely losing your petition for visa extension, being charged with a crime, or doing something DHS considers to be criminal (even if never arrested or charged) places you on the same fast-track.

Friday July 13, 2018

Monday July 16, 2018

Issue: How Health Issues Can Make You Inadmissible to the U.S.

Description: Anyone applying to visit or reside in U.S., whether on a temporary visa or a permanent green card, must prove that he or she does not present a health risk to the general public. These requirements are known as health-related grounds of inadmissibility. Attorney Jorge Rivera discussed these items.

Issue: Attorneys and Accredited Representatives Can Now File Form N-565 Online

Description: If you are an attorney or accredited representative, you can now file Form N-565, Application for Replacement Naturalization/Citizenship Document for your clients using your myUSCIS online account

Issue: Citizenship for family members

Description: Members and veterans of the U.S. armed forces and their dependents may be eligible for citizenship under special provisions of the INA.

Friday July 20, 2018

Issue: The Trump administration wants more than 400,000 people to leave the U.S. Here's who they are and why

Description: Every 18 months, Department of Homeland Security officials review whether conditions in countries under TPS have improved to the extent that people can safely return. Kirstjen Nielsen, the Homeland Security secretary, on Thursday extended TPS for roughly 500 immigrants from Somalia. It was a rare move by the Trump administration. More than 400,000 people from countries such as El Salvador, Haiti, Nicaragua and Sudan have had their legal protections stripped under the administration and must leave the U.S. within 2½ years.

When: July 23, 2018

Issue: How to request USCIS records from Immigration

Description: There are a number of immigration records available by request from USCIS; however, some records can only be obtained from the U.S. Department of State (DOS) or other DHS components such as Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) or Customs and Border Protection (CBP).

Issue: These legal immigrants might have their path to a green card blocked by Trump

Description: The Department of Homeland Security (DHS) is proposing to deny so-called "green cards" to legal immigrants and their children if they receive federal or state aid — even if the children are U.S.-born.

Issue: US temporarily scales back 'zero tolerance' immigration policy

Description: White House says administration has only temporarily halted part of its policy because it's 'going to run out of space'.

Description: President Donald Trump threatened Sunday to push the government into a shutdown ahead of the coming spending deadline in September if Congress does not fund his border wall and change the nation's immigration laws. "I would be willing to 'shut down' government if the Democrats do not give us the votes for Border Security, which includes the Wall! Must get rid of Lottery, Catch & Release etc. and finally go to system of Immigration based on MERIT! We need great people coming into our Country!" Trump tweeted.

Tuesday August 2, 2018

Issue: Civil rights groups sue president trump and ice for jailing immigrants in inhumane, unconstitutional conditions in federal prison.

Program: El Show de Alex El Genio Lucas

Description: The American Civil Liberties Union, Prison Law Office, and Civil Rights Education and Enforcement Center filed a lawsuit today against President Trump and Immigration and Customs Enforcement for violating the constitutional rights of immigrants detained at FCI Victorville, a federal prison in Victorville, California.

Wednesday August 3, 2018

Issue: Top immigration official says family detention centers are 'like summer camp'

Program: El Show de Alex El Genio Lucas

Description: Asked at a Senate Judiciary Committee hearing to describe the so-called family residential centers where kids and parents are held, Matthew Albence, the head of enforcement and removal operations for Immigration and Customs Enforcement, made the comparison of the detention centers to a summer camp.

Tuesday August 7, 2018

Issue: Trump administration planning policy to limit legal immigration

Program: El Show de Alex El Genio Lucas

Description: learned that the Trump administration is planning a new policy that could limit legal immigration by making it harder for immigrants to obtain green cards and citizenship if they've used public welfare programs.

Wednesday August 8, 2018

Issue: Over dinner, CEOs press Trump on immigration

Description: American corporate titans used a collegial dinner with President Donald Trump on Tuesday to press him on to ease immigration restrictions, according to multiple attendees. And at least during the dinner, it seemed like their coaxing had an effect. After several of the CEOs urged Trump to make it easier to allow "talented" individuals from other countries to come work at their companies in the US, the President said he would consider taking action to assuage their concerns via executive order.

Thursday August 9, 2018

Issue: Now the Trump administration wants to limit citizenship for legal immigrants

Program: El Show de Alex El Genio Lucas

Description: The Trump administration is expected to issue a proposal in coming weeks that would make it harder for legal immigrants to become citizens or get green cards if they have ever used a range of popular public welfare programs, including Obamacare.

Thursday August 16, 2018

Issue: ICE Has Tripled the Number of Undocumented Immigrants Without Criminal Records It Arrests

Program: El Show de Alex El Genio Lucas

Description: Federal arrests of undocumented immigrants with no criminal record have more than tripled under President Donald Trump and may still be accelerating, according to an NBC News analysis of Immigration and Customs Enforcement data from his first 14 months in office. The surge has been caused by a new ICE tactic of arresting — without warrants — people who are driving or walking down the street and using large-scale “sweeps” of likely immigrants, according to a class-action lawsuit filed in June by immigration rights advocates in Chicago.

Friday August 17, 2018

Issue: Under Trump, Arrests of Undocumented Migrants With No Criminal Record Triples

Program: El Show de Alex El Genio Lucas

Description: The surge appears to be caused by tactics recently adopted by ICE. Immigrants are increasingly being arrested off the street, pulled from cars or taken from sidewalks without warrants. A class action suit filed in June suggests that 'sweeps,' conducted in areas where undocumented aliens are thought to congregate, also occurs.

Monday August 20, 2018

Issue: Trump attacks Democrats' "radical policies" on immigration

Program: El Show de Alex El Genio Lucas

Description: During an event honoring Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) and Customs and Border Protection (CBP) officers at the White House Monday, President Trump attacked Democrats' "radical policies" on immigration, blaming all immigration-related crime on the party's collective "lack of knowledge, lack of understanding, or just plain stupidity."

Tuesday August 21, 2018

Issue: Trump introduces Border Patrol agent: He 'speaks perfect English'

Program: El Show de Alex El Genio Lucas

Description: President Donald Trump wanted to congratulate Border Patrol agent Adrian Anzaldua, who the president proclaimed had saved 78 lives a little over a week ago after he arrested a human smuggler. But Trump stepped on his own message when he announced on national television that Anzaldua, whose last name the president didn't attempt to pronounce, could speak "perfect English."

Wednesday August 22, 2018

Issue: USCIS Updates Policy Guidance for Certain Requests for Evidence and Notices of Intent to Deny

Program: El Show de Alex El Genio Lucas

Description: U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) today posted a policy memorandum that provides guidance to USCIS adjudicators regarding their discretion to deny an application, petition, or request without first issuing a Request for Evidence (RFE) or Notice of Intent to Deny (NOID) when required initial evidence was not submitted or the evidence of record fails to establish eligibility.

Friday August 24, 2018

Issue: Trump's new rallying cry: Mollie Tibbetts

Program: El Show de Alex El Genio Lucas

Description: On Tuesday, authorities charged a man who they said is an undocumented immigrant in the slaying of 20-year-old Mollie Tibbetts, and within hours the tragedy emerged as a polarizing wedge issue — just in time for the fall campaign homestretch.

Tuesday August 28, 2018

Issue: Refugee Processing and Security Screening

Program: El Show de Alex El Genio Lucas

Description: Reference the www.uscis.gov/refugeescreening site that provides information about the security screening and background checks required by the U.S. Refugee Admissions Program (USRAP) as well as the refugee resettlement process. The USRAP is an interagency effort which includes a number of governmental and non-governmental partners both abroad and in the United States. Refugee applicants have the highest level of background and security checks of any category of traveler to the United States.

Wednesday August 29, 2018

Issue: More than 150 arrested in massive ICE raid in Texas

Program: El Show de Alex El Genio Lucas

Description: Agents from U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement's Homeland Security Investigations (HSI) arm arrested more than 150 people Tuesday on allegations of immigration violations at a trailer manufacturer in North Texas, authorities said.

Thursday August 30, 2018

Issue: USCIS Extends and Expands Suspension of Premium Processing for H-1B Petitions to Reduce Delays

Program: El Show de Alex El Genio Lucas

Description: USCIS is extending the previously announced temporary suspension of premium processing for cap-subject H-1B petitions and, beginning Sept. 11, 2018, will be expanding this temporary suspension to include certain additional H-1B petitions. Suspensions will last until Feb. 19, 2019, and will notify the public via uscis.gov before resuming premium processing for these petitions. While H-1B premium processing is suspended, USCIS will reject any Form I-907, Request for Premium Processing Service filed with an affected Form I-129, Petition for a Nonimmigrant Worker.

Friday August 31, 2018

Issue: US Citizenships questioned by immigration authorities

Program: El Show de Alex El Genio Lucas

Description: A growing number of Americans are having their passports taken away and their citizenship called into question by immigration authorities. *The Washington Post* reported that some Latinos born in U.S. cities along the Texas-Mexico border are being denied American passports, held in immigration detention centers and placed into deportation proceedings. Others have been blocked from entering the United States.

Wednesday September 5, 2018

Issue: Income thresholds rise for Residency applicants

Program: El Show de Alex El Genio Lucas

Description: It is expected for the Trump Administration to raise the income threshold for applicants who petition to become a US Resident by 100%. Meaning if husband petitions wife and needs to make \$20k annually, new rate would increase to \$40k.

Thursday September 6, 2018

Issue: Data show that illegal immigration does not lead to more crime.

Program: El Show de Alex El Genio Lucas

Description: Years of research, using different sources of data (self-reports, arrests, convictions), at different levels of analysis (individual, city, state), conducted in different time periods, by different authors continues to show the exact same finding: Immigrants do not commit crime at higher rates than native-born Americans, and more immigration, in the aggregate, does not lead to more crime.

Monday September 10, 2018

Issue: Sessions defends 'zero tolerance' border policy, new asylum restrictions

Program: El Show de Alex El Genio Lucas

Description: Attorney General Jeff Sessions defended the Trump administration's "zero tolerance" immigration policy as "perfectly legitimate, moral and decent" during remarks to a new class of immigration judges in Falls Church, Virginia on Monday.

Tuesday September 11, 2018

Issue: After 9/11, Americans United to Protect the Country. Today, We're Divided By Threats That Don't Exist

Program: El Show de Alex El Genio Lucas

Description: Seventeen years ago today, 9/11 brought America together. Our diverse nation flew the American flag, donated blood and gathered for candlelight vigils together. On the steps of the Capitol, Republicans and Democrats in Congress sang "God Bless America" as one voice. Congress introduced strict measures and initiated monitoring as means of protection. Officials passed 48 pieces of legislation, created over 260 new government organizations and spent over \$600 billion on homeland security from 2001 to 2011.

Thursday September 13, 2018

Issue: Detention of migrant children skyrockets

Program: El Show de Alex El Genio Lucas

Description: Population levels at federally contracted shelters for young immigrants have shot up more than fivefold since last summer, to the highest level ever recorded, according to data obtained by The Times. There were 12,800 migrant children in custody this month. Some of those who work in the shelter network say bottlenecks are straining both the children and the system that cares for them. In a recent note to Congress, the White House said it intended to pay Mexico \$20 million to deport as many as 17,000 people who are in that country illegally.

Monday September 17, 2018

Issue: ICE seeking additional \$1 billion to support plans to increase deportations

Program: El Show de Alex El Genio Lucas

Description: U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement is aggressively lobbying for an additional \$1 billion to boost deportations to their highest levels yet under President Donald Trump, according to a budget document obtained by The Washington Post.

The agency urged Congress last month to include the extra funds in a stopgap spending measure that lawmakers must pass to avoid a government shutdown when the new fiscal year starts Oct. 1.

Tuesday September 18, 2018

Issue: Trump to Cap Refugees Allowed Into U.S. at 30,000, a Record Low

Program: El Show de Alex El Genio Lucas

Description: President Trump plans to cap the number of refugees that can be resettled in the United States next year at 30,000, his administration announced on Monday, further cutting an already drastically scaled-back program that offers protection to foreigners fleeing violence and persecution.

Thursday September 20, 2018

Issue: Trump's immigration roundups increasingly net non-criminals

Program: El Show de Alex El Genio Lucas

Description: ICE arrests of non-criminals increased 66% in the first nine months of the 2018 fiscal year over the same period a year earlier.

Friday September 21, 2018

Issue: Eight undocumented immigrants arrested by immigration officers in central Wisconsin

Program: El Show de Alex El Genio Lucas

Description: Immigrant agents in the central Wisconsin area have arrested 8 undocumented immigrants from Wausau, Abbotsford, Colby, and Dorchester.

Monday September 24, 2018

Issue: New Trump rule.

Program: El Show de Alex El Genio Lucas

Description: The Trump administration announced a proposed rule Saturday that would make it harder to obtain visas or green cards for immigrants already in the U.S. legally, as well as those seeking to enter, if they have ever been dependent on certain public benefits, like Medicaid, food stamps or public housing.

Tuesday September 25, 2018

Issue: Immigrant advocates vow to fight Trump plan to clamp restrictions on green card applicants

Description: Pro-immigration groups nationwide are girding for a major battle to stop or alter a Trump administration proposal unveiled over the weekend – weeks before November's midterm elections – that would strictly enforce rules for millions of immigrants applying for green cards or visas by scrutinizing their use of food stamps, welfare, housing vouchers or Medicaid.

Wednesday September 26, 2018

Issue: 5 things to know about Trump's new 'public charge' immigration proposal

Thursday September 27, 2018

Issue: House Republicans pass symbolic measure against non-citizen voting

Description: House Republicans passed a symbolic resolution Wednesday against granting undocumented immigrants the right to vote. The measure, essentially a protest against a handful of cities that sought to permit undocumented immigrants to vote in certain local elections, could give House Majority Leader Kevin McCarthy (R-Calif.) a degree of cover with immigration hard-liners within his caucus.
