

B – In accordance with perceived community needs, WNRN broadcast programs devoted to the following during its one-hour Sunday Morning interactive talk/call-in show during the quarter. Live guests representing government or community organizations were in the studio for all of the following:

- UVa AAUP chapter to discuss the issues with Theresa Sullivan/Helen Dragas confrontation and the imagery of UVa across the collegiate landscape.
- Kaz Komolafe, editor-in-chief at the Cavalier Daily, to discuss newspapers going digital and the effects of social media on the press, Cavalier Daily's role in recent UVa incidents, and reporting current events to a niche readership.
- Josh Wheeler, Director of the Thomas Jefferson Center for the Protection of Free Expression discusses the the 2013 Muzzle Awards.
- Local mothers discuss various stages and aspects of motherhood such as the decision to become a mother, naming your child, changes in parenting and more.
- Branch managers for Jefferson-Madison Regional Library and Chris Oakley, owner of Oakley's Gently Used Books offer suggestions for summer reading.
- Robyn Jackson, Director of The Civility School talks about various aspects of Civility and Manners including tips on job interviewing, the history and importance of utensil placement, why "proper" manners change depending on geographic location, Hosting/ Being a guest at parties, cell phone etiquette, etc .
- Reporter Sean Tubbs of Charlottesville Tomorrow about the history of the Western 29 Bypass since the late 80s, the politics of the bypass, the latest news about it, VDOT's reasons for accepting a flawed design bid that increased the cost by millions.
- Carla Manno of Spark of Music, A charity focused on providing musical instruments and lessons for people unable to get them, Amy Laufer of the Charlottesville City School Board, and Red Knierim of Red and the Romantics discuss the state of music education and its importance to developing children.
- Auto technicians with 50+years combined experience discuss automotive topics, answer questions and take calls.
- Lisa Potts, the resident director of Arc of the Piedmont. The arc works to improve the lives of people with intellectual or developmental disabilities. Topics discussed include mission, programs, events, funding, acceptance in society, and more.
- A local campaign focusing on young adult employment, the support IMPACT receives throughout the community, and other social concerns.
- Rene Bond, Bereavement Counselor, and Margaret Edwards, Trauma Counselor, discuss managing grief; the difference between grief, depression and sadness; and, coping with expected vs. unexpected death.
