While they ask each guest to make a \$15 per night suggested donation, over half are unable to do so -- we never turn away someone because of their ability to pay. They serve individuals who have sustained a brain injury, in order to maximize their independence. Their programs and support services help clients and their families live their best lives possible. Trauma, traumatic brain injuries and concussions can be devastating. More than 300,000 Virginians sustain a brain injury every year, and more than 4,000 folks in the Shenandoah Valley are disabled as a result of brain injury. Education/Technology	Hear Together: Virginia Discovery Museum	12/14/21-current	Throughout the day, Aired approximately 3 times.	90 seconds	Located on the downtown mall in Charlottesville, the Virginia Discovery Museum has been serving children and families for 40 years by hosting field trips, birthday parties and annual events like the Discovery Dash. Their engaging exhibits, which include the carousel that sits outside the museum's dock, have become a staple in our community. After being closed for 18 months due to the pandemic, the newly reopened museum is still finding new ways to forge connections. Through their sponsored admission program, they partner with other area nonprofits to provide free entry to patrons in need. In a recent partnership with the International Rescue Committee, refugee families can visit the museum, connect with new friends, practice language skills, and even video conference with faraway family members using the museum's wifi.
