

B – In accordance with perceived community needs, WNRN broadcast programs devoted to the following during its one-hour Sunday Morning interactive talk/call-in show during the quarter. Live guests representing government or community organizations were in the studio for all of the following:

- UVa Professor John Portman discusses Alzheimer's' disease and sex, psychology and morality involved between the relationship's partners.
- Current Events including the June, 2013 ABC Sting Operation gone bad w/ The Hook's Editor-in-chief Courteney Stuart.
- Local veterinarian Dr. Mike Feitz talks about special needs of senior pets, training puppies and answers questions from callers about their pets.
- Voices for Virginia's Children discusses the improvement of children's lives. Topics include adoption and foster care, welfare, government aid and mental health.
- Local theatre group Barhoppers perform live.
- Albemarle and Fluvanna Co school superintendents Dr. Pam Moran and Gena Kellar discuss safety in schools, SOL testing, prepping students for college/the future, and future school plans.
- UVa Prof. Paul Cantor introduces his book on Pop Culture - *The Invisible Hand In Popular Culture: Liberty vs authority in American Film and TV*.
- Members of the Big Blue Door improv/sketch comedy and storytelling group share some of their tales, experiences and discuss the process of writing sketches.
- Prof. Robert Emery, Director of the Center for Children, Families and the Law, and Author of *The Truth About Children and Divorce* explains the truths and myths how divorce affects children.
- A panel of educators and a family therapist talk about choosing colleges, careers, the choice between the two, and other various aspects of important post high-school decisions for the student and the family.
- Attorneys from Charlottesville's Legal Aid Justice Center discuss health care in prisons, the state's responsibility of health care for inmates and what happens when that responsibility is compromised.
