1/3	SCOTUS to Hear Shot Mandate Cases	Jim Schneider / Mat Staver	<p>This Friday, January 7th, the U.S. Supreme Court will be hearing oral arguments in a special session concerning COVID-19 vaccine mandates.</p> <p>What are the specifics to this case, who will be impacted and what are the implications for the nation? Returning to <i>Crosstalk</i> to look at this issue was Mat Staver. Mat is the founder and chairman of Liberty Counsel, a constitutional attorney with over 230 published legal opinions, has authored 8 scholarly law review publications. He's filed numerous briefs and argued in many federal and state courts. He has also argued two landmark cases before the Supreme Court.</p> <p>According to Mat, the U.S. Supreme Court will be taking 4 cases for review and hearing the arguments on January 11th. They fall into 2 categories all stemming from President Biden's mandates. One concerns the Occupational Health and Safety Administration (OSHA). This case involves a vaccine mandate on employers that have 100 or more employees with recipients that have Medicaid and Medicare funding. This covers healthcare workers and assisted living facilities. These cases are interesting because as Jim noted, President Biden once said he didn't have the authority to issue mandates. So the utilization of OSHA appears to be the president's attempt at an "end around" by using a regulatory agency to force a mandate upon employers.</p> <p>Mat's on the front lines of the battle, so when you review this broadcast you'll hear him as he combs through the issues explaining all the legal nuances and details in a way that listeners can understand.</p>
1/4	The Kitchen Militia	Jim Schneider / Tom DeWeese	<p>You may hear about things taking place in our nation, the legislature, your city and county government, the schools and you become frustrated at the magnitude of it all. You may throw up your arms and say, "I'm just one person! What can I do?"</p> <p>Have you ever felt that way? Many years ago when issues came up, people sprang up from all over the country to tackle oppression. They were called <i>Minutemen</i>. Today we're seeing that same thing as mothers are organizing to tackle the assault on children in the schools. Their name? <i>The Kitchen Militia!</i></p> <p>Appearing on <i>Crosstalk</i> to discuss this movement was Tom DeWeese. Tom is the president of the American Liberty Center. Tom is one of the nation's leading advocates of individual liberty, free enterprise, personal privacy, back-to-basics education and American sovereignty and independence and protection of constitutionally-guaranteed rights. He's author of <i>Sustainable: The War on Free Enterprise, Privacy, Individualism and Erase</i> a political novel.</p>

			<p>The Minutemen of 1775 were simply citizens that made the basis for the continental army. When they were needed, out they went, hence their name.</p> <p>How this pertains to today was described as Tom talked about the federal assault on children in Tom became involved in this battle in the '90's when Bill Clinton was president and he was putting in place that included Goals 2000, School to Work and The Careers Act (Also known as Workforce 2000) of this was basically socialization of the education system.</p> <p>Tom noted that the most frightening thing about all of this is that at the time there was a Republican Congress and it was Republicans that were putting these bills in place. In essence what they were eliminating the basics of history, reading, writing and arithmetic and replacing them with behavioral ideas. The idea was to get control of how the children think rather than teaching them what they should know and how they could craft children into becoming the perfect global citizen.</p> <p>Jim had Tom describe Equity Collaborative, one of the current projects that represents the model of these past efforts. Equity Collaborative is an NGO operation that has to do with how the various Loudoun County, Virginia, paid the collaborative a large sum of money to put this process into the education system.</p> <p>The problem is that those implementing this effort don't want to let adults know what the curriculum is. According to Tom, the co-founder of Equity Collaborative said that adults are in the way and that they need to change faster. For them, attitudes, values and beliefs are at the core of it so one has to wonder, what do we need to change to?</p> <p>Tom went on to describe Social Emotional Learning (SEL). This is another feelings-based concept. We have children out protesting because they're offended by someone who has a different opinion. We need to make sure we're not offending the kids, make things easy for them and once again, train them to become the perfect global citizen.</p> <p>Finally there's Critical Race Theory. Instead of resting upon the words of Martin Luther King (judging people by the color of their character rather than skin color), this ideology flips that narrative by making everything about race. For example, Tom described how CRT has affected the thinking of some people as they respond to the phenomenon of "grab and run" robberies. Bill believes America sort of has national Alzheimer's. The most free nation earth has ever seen and we've forgotten how we got here and who we are. So he feels that the best way to fix history it's like giving the memory back to someone who's lost it.</p> <p>Bill's book, <i>The Dangerous Slide Toward Socialism</i> begins with Plato. Why Plato? He wrote about Atlantis, a highly structured civilization on an island that sank into the sea. He saw them as the ideal structured society and the antithesis of an unstructured society. So he's the first person to talk about everyone owning everything in common.</p> <p>Sounds good, right? The problem is, eventually you realize that someone has to be in a position of governing the "common" stuff. Those people will always be tempted to slip something extra to their family and friends. It's not from people they don't like. 3/22	Covid Shots, Children & SMART Health Cards	Jim Schneider/ Barbara Loe Fisher	<p>COVID hospitalizations in the U.S. continue to plunge, while at the same time, there's emphasis being put on children. Now the CEO of Pfizer is saying a fourth COVID vaccine is necessary due to its waning immunity. At the same time, places like California have been looking at vaccine mandates on children. Florida has been looking for discouraging COVID vaccines for children. Tests have even been conducted on children 6 months of age. Also, while hospitalizations and deaths are dropping, at least 20 states are moving toward SMART health cards. Returning to update listeners on these vaccine related issues was Barbara Loe Fisher. Barbara is the president of Vaccine Information Center (NVIC), a non-profit charity she co-founded with parents of DPT vaccine injured children. NVIC is a national, grassroots movement and public information campaign to institute vaccine safety reform and consent protections in the public health system. She has researched, analyzed and publicly articulated the science, policy, law, ethics and politics of vaccination to become one of the world's leading non-medical advocacy experts on the subject.</p> <p>We were told to expect emergency use authorization concerning COVID vaccines for the 6 month to 4 year age group something happened. According to Barbara, several weeks ago, at the request of the FDA, Pfizer was providing that their COVID mRNA vaccine was effective and safe in children under 5 down to 6 months. A meeting was held to discuss this and suddenly they withdrew their application because they admitted they were having concerns that the vaccine was effective in that age range.</p> <p>Barbara understands that they are planning to reapply so that another meeting can be held in April and the vaccine will be applied to children in this age group.</p> <p>So what might be changing? At this point we do know that the dosage amount has been reduced to 10 micrograms (10/30) to reduce systemic reactions which are high with this particular vaccine. There's been trouble in trying to get the vaccine while at the same time also retaining some form of protection. This is important for them because children are the ones who receive most of the vaccines in the U.S.</p> <p>The troubling thing about this is that COVID-19 hasn't been hitting children like it did the elderly. The death rate has been less than 1% so the risk of complications among children has been very low. So why the push to get the vaccine? Concerning the idea of a vaccine passport, there's a private effort underway called the "Vaccine Credentialed" which is a voluntary, global coalition of public and private stakeholders that includes Microsoft, Google, Salesforce, Amazon, the Clinic, the United Healthcare Group and state governments, along with other health and technology companies. They have been involved in creating a digital proof of vaccination called the SMART Health Card.</p> <p>This health card is a type of international passport in the sense that you can show it if you're traveling to other countries. The vaccine. Barbara believes that the COVID vaccines are just the start and that eventually they'll want to have a passport.</p>
3/23	God vs. Government	Jim Schneider/ Pastor James Coates	<p>In the spring of 2020, government mandates forced churches across North America to close their doors in the COVID-19 pandemic. As societal fear and unrest increased, Christians were forced to grapple with how to respond to these state-imposed restrictions. After all, didn't the closure of churches pose a serious threat to their spiritual life? Needed spiritual direction more than ever?</p> <p>These words are on the back cover of the book, <i>God vs. Government</i> which follows two churches' decision to remain closed. The guest on this edition of Crosstalk led his congregation to return to in-person worship. They swiftly met by governing authorities ready to shut them down again. He was arrested and imprisoned for 10:25 which tells us not to forsake the assembling of ourselves together.</p> <p>Pastor James Coates is pastor-teacher of GraceLife Church of Edmonton, Canada. He's co-author of the book <i>Government: Taking a Biblical Stand When Christ & Compliance Collide</i>.</p> <p>The lock-downs for Canada began in March of 2020. Initially GraceLife Church did comply but did so reluctantly. An emergency ended in June of 2020. He had preached a couple of sermons in preparation for that though at the time still restrictions imposed on churches so they opted to open and leave it up to their congregants as to whether or not to attend.</p> <p>A key function of the book is to answer what appears to be conflict between Romans 13 and Hebrews 10:25. In wrestling with the restrictions, these texts were on their minds in terms of trying to come up with a proper response to the pandemic. They felt that in light of their ignorance it would be wise to comply with authorities since no one knew what the pandemic would be. So they began to live-stream services while data on the pandemic continued to come in. As time went on, they felt that what they were seeing was government over-reach and overreaction as the "flattening the curve" became weeks and months. Pastor Coates also cited the effects of people being isolated from one another, allowing the members of the body to come together.</p> <p>Eventually GraceLife did reopen in defiance of the government and Pastor Coates was arrested. 3/28	Questions with Eternal Consequences	Jim Schneider/ Mike Gendron	<p>Some 2,000 years ago, Jesus Christ walked the earth proclaiming the Gospel in order to seek and to save the lost. He said that he came so that they would have life and that they would have it more abundantly.</p> <p>According to the guest on this edition of Crosstalk, 339 questions are recorded in the Gospels that Jesus asked. Most are questions dealing with eternal consequences, so if the Lord used such questions in dealing with lost people, that we should learn from His example?</p> <p>Returning to Crosstalk to discuss this issue was Mike Gendron. Mike is the founder and director of Proclamation Ministry. Mike was a devout Roman Catholic for over 3 decades and was taught to rely upon the authority of the church all else. Mike searched the Scriptures and was amazed to find that what he read in Scripture contradicted the tradition of the church he had been a part of for so long. He trusted Jesus as his Savior and now the Bible is his authority in all matters of faith. Mike is the author of the books, <i>Preparing for Eternity</i> and <i>Contending for the Truth</i>. He produced numerous videos with warnings concerning false teachings vs. the truth of the Scripture.</p> <p>How is asking questions an effective means of sharing the Gospel? Mike noted that people don’t care how much you care, they know how much you care and one of the best ways you can do that is by asking questions. The other thing to remember that Jesus asked questions to confront people in their unbelief. Unbelievers don’t want to be confronted, so than sharing the truth in a preaching style, it’s better to ask questions and find out where that person is at.</p> <p>In 2 Timothy 3:15-16, we see that all Scripture is inspired by God and useful for instruction, reproof, correction, and righteousness. So when we use God’s Word to reprove others, their false beliefs are exposed, then we call them to repentance. For this purpose, asking questions is a non-threatening way to reach them without being on the defensive.</p> <p>Today we can ask Roman Catholics, and even some professing Christians, if they believe that Jesus is the Son of God, that He is truth. If they say they do, you can then ask them why they don’t believe Him? He’s also founder of Liberty Sentinel.</p> <p>If you’re a regular Crosstalk listener, you’re aware that although it’s often been called a conspiracy theory, there’s been a push for a new world order.</p> <p>That so-called conspiracy theory is now more in focus than ever before, not only since COVID hit the scene, but since March 21. On that day, President Biden, addressing the Business Roundtable CEO Quarterly Meeting, said that we have a new world order and that we have to lead it and unite the rest of the free world.</p> <p>Alex believes this is another admission of what they’ve been planning for many generations, particularly the Great Reset. He pointed out that the president was a bit misleading by suggesting that America would lead the new world order. He indicated that the plan by the architects of this order is actually to knock America down and make us simple nations that starts the order, then guides and leads it. The overarching idea is to phase out the uni-polar world order toward a multi-polar world order.</p> <p>Does the president understand this plan? Alex believes President Biden’s cognitive decline is very clear and that he doesn’t think the president really understands what’s going on. He contends that Biden is reading scripts and being told to him through his earpiece by his handlers.</p> <p>Jim provided audio of the president’s comments along with audio from Klaus Schwab, head of the World Economic Forum, the need for a great reset. Could this be viewed as an opportunity to bring about massive scarcity and depression? 3/30	ISIS Terror & Iran Nuclear Agreement	Jim Schneider/ David Rubin	<p>David Rubin is the former Mayor of Shiloh Israel and author of the book, <i>Confronting Radicals: What America Can Learn from Israel</i>. He’s the founder and president of Shiloh Israel Children’s Fund, established after he and his then wife were wounded in a terror attack. His websites are DavidRubinIsrael.com and ShilohIsraelChildren.org.</p> <p>A wave of ISIS terror has struck Israel. Last evening, Israel suffered its third major terror attack within a matter of days, multiple people dead. This follows an attack that happened this past Sunday. Just days before that, a person convicted for trying to join ISIS killed four in a stabbing spree. The attacks have left about 11 dead and a wave of terror to hit Israel in years.</p> <p>Regarding the issue of terror, David reminded listeners that it just never stops for Israel and doesn’t make sense. So when something like the war in Ukraine takes place, that ends up taking over.</p> <p>David doesn’t agree that the Israeli prime minister is using an iron fist to fight this. He’s seen a lot of American politicians come and go and more often than not, they talk a lot by saying what won’t happen, what they won’t do, they will do. Instead he’d like someone who speaks softly or not at all and carries a big stick, like Teddy Roosevelt. Jim noted how there’s no shortage of enemies for Israel. David responded by noting that they’re all aligned against Israel. They are being funded by the radical Islamic regime of Iran whose goal is the destruction of Israel and whose strategy is the destruction of the U.S.</p> <p>While all this has been unfolding, we’re approaching even closer to another Iran nuclear agreement deal, and the U.S. believes is aiding such destruction. A big part of this deal is Russia. What’s interesting about this is the fact that Jim pointed out, from one side of his mouth, President Biden is claiming Putin needs to be removed from power, other side of his mouth (and perhaps behind the curtain) he’s participating with Russia to bring about this deal. David said the deal should be subtitled, “Dirty Dealings with Shady Partners” because while Biden claims to be removing Putin from power, he’s trusting Putin to ensure that a peaceful new regime will emerge in Iran but giving the radical regime this makes no sense at all.</p> <p>As this program moved along, Jim had David comment on the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What is propelling President Biden to be so determined to negotiate with Iran and to “cozy up” to them? • Might President Biden actually be forcing Israel to launch a preemptive strike against Iran by negotiating a deal? • What are some of the “dirty deals” that David sees coming forth from the agreement with Iran? • Is there any truth to the claim that Iran has developed a missile that can hit Israel as well as the U.S.? • What impact does the former prime minister, Benjamin Netanyahu, have on Israel at this time? <p>There’s much more to consider, including what listeners had to say, on this important edition of Crosstalk.</p>

	US Nominee Vote		<p>Supreme Court.</p> <p>While COVID mandates/the military and the Supreme Court were the main topics, Jim and Mat opened their eyes remembering Terri Schiavo who made national news when on March 31 of 2005, her life was excruciatingly difficult due to starvation and dehydration in Florida.</p> <p>On Monday the 4th, the Senate Judiciary Committee will convene and take up the nomination for Ketanji White. Mat would be replacing the retiring Supreme Court Justice Stephen Breyer.</p> <p>Jackson thus far has not been able to define what a woman is, she doesn't know when life begins and she's been accused of being a pornographer. Mat believes she doesn't deserve to be on the court as her judicial philosophy is not one of objectivity but more related to activism.</p> <p>The case of Navy Seal 1 v. Austin, deals with anyone in the various branches of the military that have submitted objection requests to the COVID vaccines mandates that have been imposed by President Biden and Secretary Austin.</p> <p>According to Mat, we now know that there are more people in the military that have died in one year (2021) from the vaccine than have died in two years from COVID.</p> <p>Liberty Counsel is seeking class action. This means all persons in every branch of the military would have to sue to protect them. That injunction would include: (1) Not being forced to get the vaccine. (2) You can't be sued if you've exercised your religious right not to get the vaccine.</p> <p>Mat shared many more details, particularly in regard to the vaccine issue.
