The Iranian parliament's Nuclear Committee on Wednesday released a fact sheet to declare the revisions needed to be made in the Lausanne statement that was issued by Tehran and the world powers as a framework understanding at the end of their nuclear talks in Switzerland earlier this month.

Top 3 school districts of homeless students in Oregon: Beaverton: 1,373, Portland: 1,154, and Medford: 993.

Oregon recently passed a bill whereby anyone who is of eligible age and voting status but has not registered would be automatically signed up at the same time they receive their driver's licenses. According to host Roger Marsh and others this has "potential for voter registration fraud" written all over it. Now California is considering a very similar policy to what Oregon is implementing. Roger states quotes from state legislatures opposing the law saying they do not believe that the lack of people voting is due to the lack of availability to register.

The resolution, sponsored by Senator James Risch of Idaho—the home state of Pastor Saeed Abedini and where his wife, Naghmeh, and two young children still live—shows that Congress has not forgotten about Pastor Saeed and the other Americans wrongfully imprisoned in Iran. In light of the upcoming Senate review of any nuclear deal with Iran, this is an important statement that Senators are prioritizing the freedom of Pastor Saeed and the other U.S. citizens imprisoned in Iran.

Jilana Goble from Embrace Oregon talks about this incredible movement of the faith community partnering with DHS and the foster care system for Foster Care Awareness Month. 3,694 children spent at least one day in some kind of foster care.

2,625 of those children were placed with a relative. That means 1,069 in the Portland metro area stayed with a non-relative foster family. Of the 616 children who exited foster care in 2014, 338 (54%) were reunified with their families and 148 (24%) were adopted. The average length of stay in foster care for those children who exited in 2014 was 22 months. For every 1,000 kids in the tri-county area, only two to three children are involved in the child welfare system. Of the total children served in foster care in Oregon, 68.6 percent were Caucasian, 4.5 percent were Native American, 16.4 percent were Hispanic, 7.0 percent were African American, 1.2 percent were Asian or Pacific Islander and 2.2 percent did not have race recorded.
