Nearing 50% of this country's children - over 25 million kids under 18 - are growing up in fatherless homes. Children from fatherless homes account for: 63% of youth suicides, 71% of pregnant teenagers, 90% of runaway or homeless kids, 85% of youth sitting in prisons, 71% of high school dropouts, 75% of teens in drug treatment. Research shows that mentored children are: 46% less likely to use drugs or alcohol, 33% less likely to resort to violence, 59% more likely to get better grades.

Jilana Goble from Embrace Oregon talks about this incredible movement of the faith community partnering with DHS and the foster care system for Foster Care Awareness Month. 3,694 children spent at least one day in some kind of foster care.

2,625 of those children were placed with a relative. That means 1,069 in the Portland metro area stayed with a non-relative foster family. Of the 616 children who exited foster care in 2014, 338 (54%) were reunified with their families and 148 (24%) were adopted. The average length of stay in foster care for those children who exited in 2014 was 22 months. For every 1,000 kids in the tri-county area, only two to three children are involved in the child welfare system. Of the total children served in foster care in Oregon, 68.6 percent were Caucasian, 4.5 percent were Native American, 16.4 percent were Hispanic, 7.0 percent were African American, 1.2 percent were Asian or Pacific Islander and 2.2 percent did not have race recorded.
