Over the last 10 years, the amount of homeless individuals and families has dramatically risen in Portland. They provide safe housing, spiritual guidance, and assist residents towards self-sufficiency. Over 40 people have been successfully helped through Covenant Ministry House, utilizing their services to be able to find steady work, re-unite with their families, re-enter society after prison, and get “back on their feet.”

Rob Goff from Father's In The Field. Father's In The Field provides mentors to boys without fathers. Nearly 50% of children in our country, about 25 million children, are living in fatherless homes in the United States.

63% of youth suicide, 71% of pregnant teenage girls, 90% of runaways and homeless youth, 85% of youth in prison, 71% of high school dropout, and 75% of teens in drug treatment come from homes without fathers. Teens are 46% less likely to use drug and alcohol if they have a mentor and 33% less likely to be violent. Father's In The Field connects men with boys and gives mentor training and resources. Single mom's can also reach out to the organization on behalf of their children.

All profits from the book will be distributed to nationally recognized agencies providing either preventive or restorative service for child survivors of Domestic Minor Sex Trafficking.

Steve Buckstein of the Cascade Policy discusses Oregon Ballot Measure 86, known as the Opportunity Initiative. The measure would amend the state constitution requiring a creation of a fund for Oregonians pursuing post-secondary education, authorizing state indebtedness to pay for scholarships. Mr. Buckstein believe that citizens should vote “no” on the measure saying that the language is too vague on who would receive the funds, we should put K-12 education funding as a higher priority, and focus on solutions to reduce the cost of post-secondary education and not simply borrowing more money to supplement it.

Steve Buckstein of the Cascade Policy discusses Oregon Ballot Measure 91, which would allow for the possession, manufacture, and sale of marijuana in the state. Marijuana would be regulated by the Oregon Liquor Control Commission. The Cascade Policy institute is in favor of the bill, arguing that determining “morality” of the choices people make is not the role of government. They believe that government has stifled personal choice and business opportunity by making it an illegal substance. Steve discussed the differences in the proposed Oregon bill compared with those passed in Washington and Colorado including that the tax rates will be lower in Oregon. Steve also warned that the estimated increase in tax revenue will probably be much lower than the figures given by those in favor of the bill.

They have cleaned up parks, painted for individuals and non-profits, put on a BBQ party at a homeless shelter, and are working on rebuilding a rehab facility. Andrea points out how serving others has a positive effect on the people being served and well as those doing the serving. Building relationships in the community by being out and meeting neighbors has strengthened moral and safety in areas of town where ongoing projects are happening.

Mandi Puckett, director of NO on 91, discusses Oregon Ballot Measure 91, which would allow for the possession, manufacture, and sale of marijuana in the state. Marijuana would be regulated by the Oregon Liquor Control Commission. Mandi is a certified substance abuse specialist and mother of 3 children. The NO on 91 campaign argues that legalizing marijuana in no way improves our society. They believe that the current laws are loose enough. They see that by normalizing, promoting, and advertising marijuana that use will go up, there will be an increase in traffic fatalities, and more youth will start using. Mandi informed us that Oregon residents will be able to legally carry eight times more marijuana than is allowed in Washington and Colorado.

Jim Kelly is the chief petitioner for Oregon Ballot Measure 90. Ballot Measure 90 seeks to change the primary election structure to an “open primary.” Any registered voter would be able to vote for the candidate of their choice, regardless of party affiliation, in the primaries. The top 2 candidates would then pass the primary and be on the general election ballot. Jim and proponents believe that this will allow all voters to have equal say on who is on the general election ballot. They also believe it will stop “spoiler” third party candidates. Jim says that 90% of races in districts are dominated by one party, so that whoever wins the primary wins the election. In the open primary system it gives a better chance to a variety of candidates in those districts, according to Jim.

Ballot Measure 90 seeks to change the primary election structure to an “open primary.” Any registered voter would be able to vote for the candidate of their choice, regardless of party affiliation, in the primaries. The top 2 candidates would then pass the primary and be on the general election ballot. Sara argues that this actually eliminates voter choice in the general election. It not give minor parties a better chance at winning, but in reality will force them to have no chance and disband. They are worried about the real possibility that voters would end up with 2 candidates representing the same party or ideals being the only choices on the general election ballot. There is also a concern that the majority of the funding for this initiative has come from out of state interests Michael Bloomberg and John Arnold.

The Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) recently issued a report describing the deteriorating condition of Oregon highways. The authors estimate that the cumulative cost to the state economy from poor roads will be \$94 billion by 2035. At the same time, the Portland City Council is considering a new local income tax to pay for road maintenance and safety, citing a lack of adequate funding.

While road maintenance is indeed a problem throughout Oregon, the public is unlikely to approve new road taxes. The primary reason is a lack of trust. During the past 15 years, Portland has squandered vast amounts of money on fads like streetcars, light rail, bioswales, and “road diets.” At the state level, ODOT spent nearly two decades and \$180 million on a silly bridge-with-light-rail proposal to Vancouver, Washington that is now dead. These projects were mostly aimed at getting people “out of their cars.” Yet the reality is, regardless of how people travel, more than 99% of all trips take place on a road. So road maintenance needs to be the top priority with existing transportation dollars. New methods to pay for transportation infrastructure will eventually be needed, but politicians need to re-earn the public’s trust before that can happen.
