4/3/07 – 9-9:30 P.M.

SHOOTING BECOMES MURDER - VO

Montgomery police want to find a suspect in a shooting that left 23 year old Tyrone Hill dead. Police say 21 year old Michael Williams, who is accused of shooting Hill will be charged with murder. Williams had been charged with assault, and was released on bond. Police now want to re-arrest him. The shooting happened last night on Rigby Street. Police say Williams was playing with a handgun when it fired and hit Hill who died this morning at Jackson Hospital.

4/6/07 – 9-9:30 P.M.

MURDER TRIAL SENTENCING AMIN VO

A jury in Camden recommends that Johnny Pettway be sentenced to life in prison without parole for the murders of two people. That recommendation goes to the judge who can overrule the jury and sentence Pettway to death. Pettway was convicted this week of killing Jessie Fisher and his wife Barbara in 2003 then setting their home on fire. Records show Pettway served ten years in prison in the 1980s for strangling his neighbor to death. A sentencing date hasn't been announced.

4/9/07 – 9-9:30 P.M.

DOUBLE SHOOTING – VO

Police are still searching for the Alfred Cobb, a suspect in a double shooting that happened on Easter Sunday. Police say the shooting happened after an argument broke out between the two victims and the suspect. The fight happened after Cobb was accused of leaving a small child in a convenience store. Both victims are in fair condition and are expected to recover. Call police if you have seen Cobb. The number is 262-4000.

4/11/07 – 9-9:30 P.M.

CHILD PORN ARREST

A Montgomery man is out on bail tonight after being charged with possession of child pornography. Police arrested 25 year old Keith Anderson yesterday who has since been released on 20 thousand dollars bond. Officials took his home computer after his arrest. Three different law enforcement departments worked the case. A trial date has not been scheduled at this time.

4/16/07 – 9-9:30 P.M.

VIRGINIA TECH SHOOTING

Investigators work to make sense of a senseless crime. A gunman kills 32 people at Virginia Tech University before killing himself. University officials say a gunman went on a deadly shooting spree on the campus of Virginia Polytechnic Institute in Blacksburg, Virginia early this morning shooting students and faculty members. The university was struck with a tragedy of monumental proportions. VTU's president said police were called to a dorm about 7:15 A.M. Students in the dorm reported hearing as many as 40 shots fired. About two hours later, a second shooting was reported at a campus building that houses the Engineering Department.

4/17/07 – 9-9:30 P.M.

VA TECH SHOOTING UPDATE – PKG.

It is now known who is responsible for Monday's shooting massacre on the campus of Virginia Tech. 23-year-old Cho Seung-Hui was an English major from South Korea. The shooting is being called the deadliest shooting rampage in the country's history. 33 people, including the gunman, has died and dozens more are wounded. There's still no indication of why Cho went on a killing spree.

4/24/07 – 9-9:30 P.M.

LINDEN DRUG ARREST – WIPE VO

Linden police make a big drug bust. Eric Walton of Linden is under arrest. Police say he was selling drugs out of his SUV. Officers say they found 27-grams of marijuana, nearly 8-grams of crack cocaine, almost 3-grams powder cocaine, nearly 800 dollars in cash, and a set of scales.

4/30/07 – 9-9:30 P.M.

TUSKEGEE SHOOTING

18 year old student Canon Jones was found shot to death around 8:30 last night about a half mile from campus on old Montgomery road. It's actually right across from the mansion of the university president. It's believed Jones was the victim of an apparent robbery. Even though the incident happened off campus, university police say they're beefing up patrol.

4/30/07 – 9-9:30 P.M.

JD SHOOTING WIPE VO

A 16 year old boy is recovering after being shot in Montgomery this weekend while in his car. Police say he teen was driving in front of Front Street Entertainment on Wallace Drive when another person drove up and fired into the car. The victim's name has not yet been released. The 16 year old did not suffer serious injuries.

5/2/07 – 9-9:30 P.M.

SCHOOL BOMB THREAT – AMIN VO

A fourteen year old boy has been expelled from school after police say he threatened to kill a teacher and blow up the school. From the CW News at 9 Elmore county mobile newsroom, authorities say the Eclectic Middle school student admitted to making the threats - - even telling police how he'd kill the teacher. He was arrested yesterday. The judge sent him to a juvenile detention center in Montgomery.

5/4/07 – 9-9:30 P.M.

MPD INITIATIVE – VO

Montgomery police announce two new initiatives to help combat crime in the capital city. Montgomery police chief Art Baylor announced the new initiatives at a press conference today. One will be more bike patrols at local businesses and in neighborhoods. Another initiative is called the rapid response team - - which will be police officers driving unmarked cars. Baylor says all parts of the city will be included in the increased police patrol.

5/8/07 – 9-9:30 P.M.

COWART TRIAL

A Montgomery county jury finds a man guilty in a five year old murder case. This is the second time in just over a month that prosecutors have tried Anthony Cowart and today it took a jury just under two hours to find him guilty of the murder of 23 year old Reginald Sharp. Authorities say Anthony Cowart was one of four men who beat Sharp, placed a plastic bag around his head and shot him twice. Sharp's remains were found in a wooded area off of old Selma road back in 2004. Prosecutors say the altercation started when the men were at a drug house on Rosa Parks Avenue.

5/10/07 – 9-9:30 P.M.

Harold Guy Verdict – VO

From Tallapoosa County, a man is sentenced to life in prison for leaving his stepdaughter inside a burning home to die. Harold Guy was convicted in Alexander City for the murder of 14-year-old Amanda Moler last year. In a sworn statement to police, Guy said he left Moler in the house in New Site and he didn't care if she died as long as his own daughter wasn't hurt. Guy will go back to trial later this year on sex abuse charges involving another stepdaughter.

5/14/07 – 9-9:30 P.M

MAY DAY ARREST – ANIM VO TAG

Police now say they made more than 40 arrests during the May Day celebration in Opp. Opp police called in dozens of extra officers to patrol the event - from the state troopers to alcoholic beverage control agents. Officials say most of the people arrested are now facing felony and misdemeanor drug charges. Authorities also recovered 5 thousand dollars in cash.

5/21/07 – 9-9:30 P.M.

DUSTIN PROVITT MURDER – WIPE VO

Montgomery Police have made another murder arrest. Eddie Blue is charged in the death of Dustin Provitt on Saturday. Police found Provitt shot at Virginia Meadows Apartments in south Montgomery. Police say Blue confessed to the murder and is being held on a \$50,000 bond.

5/24/07 – 9-9:30 P.M.

BUTLER CO. DRUG BUST – ANIM VO

One man is behind bars after a drug bust in Butler County. Anthony Maye was arrested when authorities say he went to water marijuana plants in a field. The Butler County Sheriffs office and the Alabama Conservation department had been watching the field before they arrested him. The pot has a street value of 100,000 dollars. Maye is being held in the Butler County Jail under a 10-thousand dollar bond.

6/4/07 – 9-9:30 P.M.

TALLASSEE SHOOTING – VO

There were some tense moments for some Tallassee residents when an argument led to gunfire. Tallassee police responded to a home on Wall Street and said that no one was shot but they took one person into custody. Officials say the shooting happened after an argument over a stolen vehicle.

6/7/07 – 9-9:30 P.M.

SELMA SHOOTING UPDATE

One of two brothers charged with killing a security guard is being charged as an adult in Dallas County's 3rd murder of the year. 18-year-old Corey Pullom and his brother, 16-year-old Demarion Pullom are both charged with killing 35-year-old Steven Agüero who died after being shot outside Jim Minor Garden Homes Monday night. Agüero provided security for the property, and was actually giving a Selma police officer a statement about a different problem there, when the shots rang out. Corey is being held under a \$300,000 bond, Demarion is being held under a \$500,000 bond.

6/12/07 – 9-9:30 P.M.

RAPE BOND HEARING – ANIM VO

A Selma man is facing charges after being arrested for a rape that happened in 2005. Selma police say 42 year old Michael Andrew Barlow was charged with kidnapping and rape. Police say Barlow pulled a 20 year old woman down an embankment into a creek bed near Block Park in Selma, and then raped her repeatedly. Police recovered evidence from the victim, and tells the CW News at 9 the DNA matches that of Barlow.

6/21/07 – 9-9:30 P.M.

FORMER COP CHARGES – VO

No trial date has been set yet for a former Covington county sheriff's candidate, arrested on rape charges. A grand jury has indicted Kevin Owens on rape charges. Owens ran for sheriff of Covington County last year. At the time of his arrest, he was working for the Andalusia police department.

6/22/07 – 9-9:30 P.M.

CHILD SEX ABUSE ARREST – VO

An agent with the Alcohol Beverage Control board is arrested on sexual abuse charges. Police arrested Anthony Isbell yesterday and charged him with inappropriate contact with a female juvenile. Police are not releasing details because the case is still under investigation. Isbell is being held in jail on \$100,000 bond.

4/2/07 – 9-9:30 P.M.

STORM RELIEF DEADLINE - VO

Victims of the March first tornados have a little longer to register for help from the Federal Emergency management Agency. Residents in 7 Alabama counties - including Coffee, Dallas, Montgomery and Wilcox counties have until May second to get assistance. FEMA has kept registration open for families whose insurance company won't cover the whole cost. If you need help, you can apply for aid by calling 1-800-621-FEMA or going on line to fema.gov.

4/3/07 – 9-9:30 P.M.

POWER DAY PRE K - VO

Pre-Kindergarten groups from across the state talk with state legislators about the positive impact of early education. Alabama is one of only two states to receive the top score for the quality of its state-funded preschool programs. However, Alabama placed near the bottom for the number of children enrolled in the state's preschool program. State funding supports 59 preschools in Alabama.

4/11/07 – 9-9:30 P.M.

ANNE ROMNEY VISIT – VO

The wife of a Republican Presidential Candidate is making another visit to the Capital City. Anne Romney, Wife of former Massachusetts Governor Mitt Romney is speaking to the Alabama Federation of Republican Women. Mrs. Romney is just the latest in a string of Presidential Candidates and their family members to visit Alabama. Afterwards she spoke to reporters about her husband.

4/11/07 – 9-9:30 P.M.

PENN BILL – VO

A new bill being proposed in the legislature would use bingo money to help local agencies is being sponsored by Senator Myron Penn. The bill would require private operators of charity bingos in Macon County to pay annual fees to assist the local government and sheriff's office. Each year, Two million dollars would go to the county commission to help pay the general costs of government. Another 750 thousand would go to the sheriff's department and a half million to gambling enforcement agencies.

4/16/07 – 9-9:30 P.M.

DOW ANNOUNCE

Montgomery Mayor Bobby Bright now has some competition in efforts to win re-election this year. Jonathan Dow says he's in the race for three reasons, to improve education, to bring more business to the city, and to improve communication between citizens and government officials. Community activist William Boyd announced in February that he will run. Mayor Bobby Bright is seeking his third term. The election is in October.

5/1/07 – 9-9:30 P.M.

LEGISLATURE HALF WAY – LL PKG.

The second half of the legislative session is off to a slow start in the House. It took over five minutes for enough members to show up to reach a quorum, but don't let that fool you. They say they're the ones doing all the work. In all, three measures have made their way to Governor Riley's desk. They include pay raises for state employees and legislators and funding to help rebuild Enterprise schools.

5/1/07 – 9-9:30 P.M.

IMMIGRATION NEWSER – VO

Illegal immigration is a hot topic across the country, but some Alabama groups don't want the Legislature to crack down on illegal immigration here. Several groups that work with Hispanics and Latinos want Alabama to let Congress develop a national immigration policy instead. At a news conference in Montgomery they say they want Governor Bob Riley to change his position. Riley has submitted bills to make Alabama the toughest in the nation on immigration policy.

5/2/07 – 9-9:30 P.M.

RON SPARKS RUNNING – VO

Agriculture commissioner Ron Sparks may be considering a run for the U-S Senate. Sparks, who's a Democrat, says he is considering running against Republican U-S Senator Jeff Sessions, who is in his second term in office. That Senate election is next year. Sparks spoke with us in an exclusive one on one interview about his possible run.

5/8/07 – 9-9:30 P.M.

ATTEMPTED TERRORIST ATTACK – PKG.

Six men accused of plotting an attack on an Army base in New Jersey, have been ordered held without bail. The FBI says the group planned to kill as many soldiers as possible at Fort Dix. As Karen Brown reports the suspects made a simple mistake that tipped off authorities. The defendants also allegedly spoke of attacking a Navy installation in Philadelphia during the annual Army-Navy college football game, when the place would be full of sailors.

5/9/07 – 9-9:30 P.M.

RILEY SIGNS INCENTIVE BILL – VO

Governor Bob Riley takes the final step in trying to lure a German steel plant to Alabama. Today, he signed a bill to offer the company tax incentives. Now it's up to officials with ThyssenKrupp to decide if the incentives are enough to get them to build a nearly 3-billion dollar mill near Mobile. Louisiana is also trying to get the plant which would bring at least 2,000 jobs. Company officials are expected to decide where to build by early Friday morning.

5/10/07 – 9-9:30 P.M.

EDWARDS COMING – VO

From Campaign 2008 - Democratic Presidential Candidate John Edwards has been invited to speak to the Alabama Legislature. Edwards plans to be in Montgomery on May 24th to speak to a joint session of the Legislature. Edwards is a former one-term US Senator from North Carolina.

5/24/07 – 9-9:30 P.M.

MARINES DEPLOY – VO

Members of the U-S Marine Reserve unit 323 leave Montgomery heading for duty in Iraq for their second deployment. Nearly 200 marines left in two groups and will stop briefly in North Carolina for training at Camp Lejune. A fourth of the company went to Iraq in 2003. The unit (from Alabama, Georgia and Florida) will stay there for about a year.

6/4/07 – 9-9:30 P.M.

AUTAUGA WATER - GFX

Water restrictions have now started for people in the Northeast area of Autauga County. The Autauga county water authority has issued a limit to outdoor watering to an odd-even system. Customers whose addresses end with even numbers may water on Monday and Thursday only. Those with odd-numbered addresses may water only on Tuesday and Friday. No watering at all is allowed on Wednesday, Saturday and Sunday. It's also banned between 10 in the morning and 10 at night.

6/8/07 – 9-9:30 P.M.

LEGISLATURE OVER – VO

The legislative session ended yesterday, despite a few set backs, both the house and senate did get some work done. The House passed bills aimed at curbing copper thefts; they also passed a bill allowing 17-year-olds to donate blood on their own and 16 year olds to donate blood with parents' permission; the senate approved a bill to allow public school students to give themselves asthma medication. The education trust fund budget and the general fund budget were both signed by Governor Bob Riley. House speaker Seth Hammett talked about what he thinks is the biggest accomplishment by legislators this session.

6/11/07 – 9-9:30 P.M.

SELMA, GREENVILLE, TROY WATER – SOT,VO,GFX

Selma has put restrictions on water usage; Greenville is considering voluntary water restrictions to conserve that city's water supply; the Mayor of Troy says the city is not in a shortage but he wants water resources to be better used. Selma residents can only use water one day per week; in Troy, residents with odd-numbered addresses are asked to water only on odd-numbered days; those with even-numbered addresses on even days.

6/12/07 – 9-9:30 P.M.

ELMORE COUNTY TOWNS WATER – ANIM VO

Four towns in Elmore County are now under mandatory water restrictions. Millbrook, Coosado, Deatsville and the town of Elmore are all under the restrictions.
