WYYS is a unique station in that it covers a wide variety of subjects and issues that concern residents of the immediate and surrounding listening area. Licensed in Streator, WYYS lends a great deal of focus on issues that concern the rural landscape as well as urban areas, in hopes that there is not an alienation of a group or groups of people and their varying lifestyles.

Issue: Agriculture/Agribusiness

Agriculture and Agribusiness is a way of life for many in this area and we do our best to keep listeners up to date on these issues.

Program: Potatoes. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners about a potential potato shortage. Aired 12/4 at 10:32am.

Program: Harvesting Delays. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that the snowfall has stopped harvesting, but farmers are treating this as if it were rainfall, and expecting to resume harvesting next week. Aired 10/31 at 6:00am.

Program: Weather Extremes. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that harvest season is continuing to pose challenges for farmers across LaSalle County due to various weather extremes that began in the Spring. Aired 11/19 at 8:00am.

Program: Tariff Negotiations. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that the LaSalle County Farm Bureau President says farmers are optimistic as tariff negotiations are in the works for the U.S. and China. Aired 12/17 at 7:00am.

Program: Late Crop. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that LaSalle County farmers are making progress harvesting a late crop, but the Farm Bureau President doesn't think all farmers will be done by Christmas. Aired 12/20 at 6:00am and 8:00am.

Issue: Animal Welfare

Some may feel that animal welfare is trivial, however, the way a society treats its most vulnerable is indicative of its compassion as a whole.

Program: Dog Rescued. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that a dog was rescued after finding himself in a pond. Aired 12/12 at 6:00am.

Issue: Arts and Culture

Promoting local shows is important, as it keeps the local entertainment industry employed. Also, it keeps the masses entertained and connected to the community.

Program: The Games Afoot. Broadcast thirty thirty second messages informing listeners about the production of The Games Afoot at Stage 212 and encouraging listeners to attend. See Appendix A and Appendix C for broadcast times.

Issue: Charity

Charity is important in boosting up those who need help, and improves the quality of life for the entire community

Program: LaSalle County Days of Hope. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that Relay For Life of LaSalle County and Relay For Life of Upper Illinois Valley have joined forces to create the LaSalle County Days of Hope. Aired 10/10 at 6:00am and 8:00am.

Program: Food Pantry. Broadcast two messages informing listeners that Mike Krzak, a local attorney, announced a two thousand five hundred dollar donation to the Illinois Valley Food Pantry. Aired 12/6 for one minute and fifty seconds at 12:30pm, and 12/9 for one minute and thirty seconds at 12:29pm.

Program: Salvation Army. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that the Illinois treasurer's office has returned nearly forty thousand dollars to the Salvation Army in Chicago. Aired 12/26 at 7:00am and 8:00am.

Issue: Community

Community organizations build a community bond and also are an outlet for charitable giving in a town.

Program: Bonds. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that the city of Ottawa approved selling three point seven million dollars in bonds for their lift station project and an already completed water main replacement. Aired 10/2 at 7:00am.

Program: Burgoo Interview. Broadcast a two minute and thirty-seven second interview with a representative from the Burgoo Festival about the upcoming event. Aired 10/9 at 8:37am.

Program: New Equipment. Broadcast a fifteen second message informing listeners that Streator's Fire Department will be getting new vehicle extrication equipment. Aired 10/17 at 6:00am.

Program: Halloween Safety. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners of some tips from the LaSalle County Sheriff's Office for making sure your child visits a safe area when trick or treating. Aired 10/28 at 7:00am.

Program: Key to the City. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that the key to the city of Ottawa was awarded to Don and Betty Gillette for developing the festival of lights parade and music in the park. Aired 11/6 at 7:00am.

Program: Cookies. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that a nine-year-old girl from the Grand Ridge area baked over three thousand cookies to support children in Uganda. Aired 11/14 at 7:00am and 8:00am.

Program: Mayoral Interview. Broadcast two interviews with Mayor Jeff Grove regarding the Celebration of Lights. Aired 12/20 for two minutes and fifteen seconds at 8:12am and for three minutes and twenty-six seconds at 8:17am.

Program: One Hundred Dollar Minute. Broadcast thirty-one thirty second messages informing listeners of the rules of the one hundred dollar minute game and encouraging them to play. See Appendix B for broadcast times.

Issue: Crime and Safety

Crime and Safety is always an important issue. A notable homicide took place last quarter, a missing Spring Valley girl was found dead in Putnam County, Diamond Bradley

Program: Metal Cane. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that authorities are searching for a man who attacked an eighteen year old Chicago bus passenger with a metal cane while screaming racist and anti-immigrant slurs at him. Aired 10/4 at 6:00am and 8:00am.

Program: Potential Terrorism. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that the family of a man facing an Illinois terrorism charge for plowing an SUV into a suburban Chicago mall says he shouldn't be called a "terrorist" because there was no political reason behind his action. Aired 10/4 at 7:00am and 8:00am.

Program: Nine-Year-Old. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that a prosecutor says a central Illinois nine-year-old will be charged with five counts of first-degree murder in connection with a mobile home fire that killed five people. Aired 10/9 at 8:00am.

Program: Fire Murder. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that an Ogle County man has been charged with first-degree murder in the death of his son and ex-wife in a fire. Aired 10/10 at 6:00am and 8:00am.

Program: Youth Basketball Team. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that a forty-four year old northern Illinois man has been arrested on charges that he stole thousands of dollars from a youth basketball team in a league he once ran. Aired 10/14 at 7:00am.

Program: Falling Death. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that authorities say a man has died after falling almost fifty feet from an overhang at Starved Rock State Park. Aired 10/21 at 6:00am and 8:00am.

Program: Social Security Scams. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that an elderly person from Streator shipped a package with ten thousand dollars in it unknowingly to Social Security Scammers, but the police were able to intervene and remind everyone that government agencies do not contact people by phone. Aired 10/21 at 7:00am.

Program: Bus Aide. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that a former northern Illinois bus aide was charged with aggravated battery to a child after dragging him to a seat and striking the child. Aired 10/25 at 6:00am.

Program: Gas Leak. Broadcast a twenty-two second message informing listeners that there was a gas leak in Peru. Aired 12/10 at 1:00pm.

Program: Grain Bin. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that a Walnut man is dead after falling into a grain bin. Aired 10/30 at 6:00am.

Program: Starved Rock State Park. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that a body was discovered in the Illinois River at Starved Rock State Park. Aired 11/4 at 6:00am and 8:00am. Broadcast a thirty second update informing listeners that the identity of the body found in the Illinois River near Starved Rock State Park has been released. Aired 11/6 at 6:00am.

Program: Two Alarm. Broadcast a fifteen second message informing listeners that a two alarm fire south of Ottawa damaged at least one building at a business. Aired 11/8 at 6:00am.

Program: Illinois River. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that a man was reportedly found dead after a vehicle went into the Illinois River in Ottawa. Aired 11/8 at 6:00am, 7:00am, and 8:00am.

Program: Phone Scam. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that authorities are warning residents about a phone scam involving people calling residents claiming to be with the Will County Sheriff's Office. Aired 11/11 at 7:00am.

Program: Bribery. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that a federal bribery charges against an Illinois legislator has led to questions about whether lawmakers be allowed to lobby other units of government. Aired 11/12 at 8:00am.

Program: Bradley Murder. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that a Peoria County judge watched Jose Ramirez say that he stabbed his parents in a videotaped confession played on the first day of the Princeville man's murder trial. Aired 11/18 at 7:00am.

Program: Inmate. Broadcast a fifteen second message informing listeners that the longest serving inmate in the state is up for a parole hearing. Aired 11/21 at 6:00am, 7:00am, and 8:00am.

Program: House Fire. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that two people are dead after an early morning house fire in Streator. Aired 11/25 at 6:00am, 7:00am, 7:30am, and 8:00am.

Issue: Daylight Savings

We feel it is important for people to be reminded of the time change and to remember to change their smoke detectors.

Program: Daylight Savings Time. Broadcast a twenty-two second message reminding listeners that Daylight Savings Time is ending. Aired 10/2 at 7:03am.

Issue: Drug Abuse

Drug Abuse is becoming a scourge of society, with opium overdose, costing the nation, just economically, nearly 80 billion a year.

Program: Opioid Settlement. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that Streator could get the highest amount of money in LaSalle County's opioid settlement due to the high number of overdoses. Aired 10/2 at 6:00am.

Program: Cocaine and Firearms. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that a man arrested for alleged drug sales in Mendota faces more charges following a search of his home where police say they found cocaine and firearms. Aired 10/17 at 6:00am.

Program: Methamphetamines. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that two Michigan women were charged with possession of over thirty pounds of suspected methamphetamines after a traffic stop near Senica. Aired 10/22 at 6:00am.

Program: Cocaine. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that a woman allegedly involved in dealing cocaine around Peru, was taken into custody on multiple charges, including unlawful delivery of a controlled substance. Aired 10/24 at 7:00am. Also broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that one man is in custody after a buy/bust operation in LaSalle when agents say they purchased approximately two grams of purported cocaine. Aired 11/20 at 7:00am.

Program: Traffic Stop. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that two people were sent to county jail with drug charges after Illinois State Police allegedly found methamphetamines during a traffic stop. Aired 10/29 at 7:00am.

Program: Cannabis. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that police arrested a Rockford man after finding marijuana hidden in his minivan along I-80 in Nebraska. Aired 11/7 at 7:00am.

Program: Dispensary. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that a medical marijuana dispensary in Ottawa will be allowed to sell recreationally in January. Aired 12/5 at 7:00am.

Program: Heroin. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that an Ottawa man is charged with unlawful delivery of over one gram of purported heroin. Aired 12/9 at 7:00am.

Issue: Economy

“it’s the Economy, Stupid” – quote from Bill Clinton’s Presidential Campaign, 1992. Without a strong economy, nothing else matters.

Program: Chicago Budget. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that Chicago mayor Lori Lightfoot is expected to detail how the nation’s third largest city should deal with the budget deficit when she delivers her budget address to the City Council. Aired 10/23 at 7:00am.

Program: LaSalle Speedway. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that LaSalle Speedway is up for sale and that all operations are to cease immediately. Aired 10/24 at 6:00am.

Program: Del Monte. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that Del Monte announced that they have found a buyer for the Mendota facility. Aired 11/20 at 6:00am and 7:30am.

Program: Cannabis. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that the LaSalle County Board will wait to act on approving or rejecting the sale of cannabis on Unincorporated areas until January. Aired 12/10 at 8:00am.

Program: Health and Fitness Expo. Broadcast two hundred and nine thirty second messages informing listeners about the upcoming Health and Fitness Expo and encouraging consumers to attend and vendors to partake. See Appendix D and Appendix E for broadcast times. Also broadcast live from the Health and Fitness Expo from 10am until 1pm on 10/5.

Program: Saturday Sales. Broadcast a two hour live event at Brother’s Country Supply for their first and last Saturday Sales events leading up to Christmas encouraging listeners to attend and support local businesses. Aired 11/30 from 10:00am until 12:00pm and 12/21 from 10:00am until 12:00pm.

Program: Christmas in the Village. Broadcast a two hour live event for Christmas in the Village encouraging listeners to attend and support local vendors in honor of the holidays. Aired 11/30 from 12:00pm until 2:00pm.

Program: Sherman’s. Broadcast a two hour live event at Sherman’s encouraging listeners to come get a picture with Santa and to support local businesses. Aired 12/7 from 10:00am until 12:00pm.

Program: ChristKindle Market. Broadcast a two hour live event at the ChristKindle Market encouraging listeners to attend and support the local vendors. Aired 12/7 from 12:00pm until 2:00pm.

Program: Jeff Perry. Broadcast a two hour live event at the Jeff Perry Buick GMC encouraging listeners to attend and support local business. Aired 12/14 from 10:00am until 12:00pm.

Issue: Education

An Investment in Knowledge Pays The Best Interest – Benjamin Franklin

Program: Financial Aid. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that state officials say free workshops and support for students seeking financial aid for college is available throughout the fall starting this month. Aired 10/7 at 7:00am.

Program: Welcoming Atmosphere. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that a protest claiming Illinois State University doesn't offer a welcoming atmosphere to black students has prompted the school's president to call a meeting with demonstrators. Aired 10/9 at 7:00am.

Program: Leadership and Service. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that the Illinois Valley Community College board honored former ten year trustee Melissa Olivero of Peru for her leadership and service to the college. Aired 10/11 at 7:00am.

Program: Negotiation. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that the teachers union and District 289 failed to reach an agreement after a seven hour long negotiation that lasted until well after midnight. Aired 10/16 at 6:00am, 7:00am, and 8:00am. Also broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that students at the three District 289 Schools in Mendota remain out of class for the fifth straight day due to failed negotiations. Aired 10/22 at 6:00am.

Program: President. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that Illinois state Senator Chuck Weaver has applied to become the next president of Bradley University. Aired 11/11 at 7:00am.

Issue: Emergency Alert System

As a participating station in the EAS system, we receive and send tests and warnings.

Program: EAS tests. Sent the required monthly and weekly tests. Sent Thunderstorm Warnings on 11/27 at 1:03am. See Appendix G for broadcast times.

Issue: Environmental Issues

With the importance of climate change, and with tourism dependent on 3 state parks in the area, environmental issues are important to local people.

Program: Solar Farm. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that the Village of DePue will be home to the largest solar farm in Bureau County, advancing the state's goal of reaching a quarter percent of renewable energy by 2025. Aired 10/15 at 7:00am.

Program: Coal Tar Cleanup. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that workers involved in the coal tar cleanup at the former Central School site in Ottawa are preparing for heavy duty work in the new year. Aired 12/19 at 6:00am and 8:00am.

Issue: Government

Government is important in society to prevent anarchy and it is beneficial to the population to be informed on what the government is doing.

Program: Auditor's Office. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that LaSalle County board members voted in favor of a referendum regarding eliminating the county auditor's office in the November 2020 election. Aired 10/11 at 6:00am.

Program: Census Bureau. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that the U.S. Census Bureau has asked the fifty states for drivers' license information, months after President Trump ordered the collection of citizenship information. Aired 10/14 at 6:00am and 8:00am.

Program: Secretary of State Office. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that Saturday will be the last day that the Secretary of State Office in Ottawa is open. Aired 10/16 at 7:00am.

Program: Federal Complaint. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that Illinois House Speaker Madigan says a lawmaker accused of bribery in a federal complaint should resign or be removed. Aired 10/29 at 6:00am.

Program: Ethics Reform. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that State Senator Sue Rezin joined several Illinois Lawmakers to call for ethics reform legislation. Aired at 10/31 at 7:00am.

Program: Blagojevich. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that President Donald Trump has again floated the idea of freeing former Illinois governor Rod Blagojevich from federal prison. Aired 11/1 at 6:00am.

Program: Census Count. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that the North Central Illinois Council of Governments will hold a free regional Census Complete Count training for community groups and local governments this week. Aired 11/5 at 7:00am.

Program: Comprehensive Plan. Broadcast a twenty second message informing listeners that the Oglesby Planning Commission is continuing to involve the public in reviewing the 2019 Comprehensive Plan. Aired 11/13 at 7:00am.

Program: State Senator. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that Democratic state Senate President John Cullerton has announced that he's stepping down from the Illinois Legislature. Aired 11/15 at 6:00am.

Program: New Laws. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that the start of 2020 will trigger more than two hundred and fifty new Illinois Laws, including laws affecting education, job applicants, crime, parents, and the LGBTQ community. Aired 12/30 at 6:00am.

Issue: Health/Wellness

This station recognizes that health is an important component in today's society. More and more listeners are taking up healthy lifestyles. Of course, there are always health scares and concerns to cover as well.

Program: Suicide Prevention. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that people from all different walks of life will gather on Saturday in Ottawa to advocate for suicide prevention. Aired 10/8 at 6:00am. Also broadcast live from the Walk to Fight Suicide from noon to 2pm on 10/12.

Program: Fall Fitness 5k. Broadcast live for 2.5 hours for the IVCH Fall Fitness 5k, which encouraged local listeners to get in shape. Aired from 7:30 to 10am on 10/12.

Program: Urgent Care. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that residents of Mendota, Streator, and the surrounding areas will have increased access to urgent care facilities this fall when OSF PromptCare will open in Mendota and OSF Healthcare Center for Health opens in Streator. Aired 10/18 at 7:00am.

Program: Vaping. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that a third Illinois resident has died after being hospitalized with a vaping-related lung injury. Aired 11/1 at 7:00am. Broadcast another thirty second message informing listeners that a fifth Illinois resident has died due to a vaping-related lung injury. Aired 11/22 at 6:00am.

Program: Diabetes. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that the Illinois House has approved legislation to cap the amount diabetes patients must pay for insulin to one hundred dollars a month. Aired 11/14 at 6:00am and 7:00am.

Program: Apples. Broadcast a twenty-six second message informing listeners that two apples a day help to lower blood pressure, cholesterol, and the risk of heart attack. Aired 12/20 at 11:32am.

Program: Flu Shot. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that it isn't too late in the season to get a flu shot and that the LaSalle County Health Department will be holding an additional flu clinic on Thursday. Aired 12/2 at 6:00am and 8:00am.

Program: Better Business Bureau. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that the Better Business Bureau is warning of online shopping scams during the holidays. Aired 12/3 at 7:00am.

Program: OSF Healthcare. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that OSF Healthcare and community partners re-opened their brand new facility in Streator. Aired 12/6 at 7:00am.

Program: HIV. Broadcast a thirty second public service announcement informing listeners about the danger of HIV and the importance of raising awareness for it. See Appendix F for broadcast times.

Issue: Home and Lifestyle

Keeping ones home maintained in extreme Northern Illinois weather is an important priority, especially with our area's propensity to flood with such an undeveloped drainage system.

Program: Flood Damage. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that the LaSalle County Emergency Management Agency will be conducting assessments for residents that have experienced flood related damages to their properties. Aired 10/1 at 6:00am.

Program: Lee's Water Systems. Broadcast several interviews with a representative from Lee's Water Systems regarding safe water. Aired 10/1 for two minutes and four seconds at 9:22am, 10/2 for two minutes and fourteen seconds at 9:22am, 10/3 for two minutes and eight seconds at 9:22am, 10/8 for two minutes and five seconds at 9:21am, 10/9 for one minute and fifty-five seconds at 9:19am, 10/10 for one minute and fifty-nine seconds at 9:20am, 10/15 for two minutes at 9:24am, 10/16 for two minutes and twenty-eight seconds at 9:25am, 10/22 for one minute and fourteen seconds at 9:22am, 10/23 for two minutes at 9:17am, 10/24 for two minutes and seven seconds at 9:23am, 11/5 for one minute and forty-nine seconds at 9:21am, 11/6 for two minutes and two seconds at 9:26am, 11/7 for two minutes and sixteen seconds at 9:21am, 11/12 for one minute and forty-seven seconds at 9:26am, 11/14 for two minutes and twenty seconds at 9:22am, 11/21 for two minutes and forty-two seconds at 9:19am, 11/26 for two minutes and thirteen seconds at 9:20am, 12/4 for two minutes and twenty-four seconds at 9:21am, 12/5 for two minutes and four seconds at 9:22am, 12/10 for one minute and thirty-six seconds at 9:24am, 12/11 for two minutes and forty-three seconds at 9:02am, 12/12 for two minutes and six seconds at 9:14am, 12/17 for two minutes and fifteen seconds at 9:20am, 12/18 for one minute and fifty-five seconds at 9:21am.

Program: Smoke Detectors. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that Illinoisans will soon be required to upgrade their smoke detectors to ones that have a ten-year sealed battery. Aired 10/18 at 8:00pm.

Program: Water. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that the city of Ottawa and the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency detected some homes with elevated lead levels in their water. Aired 11/21 at 7:00am.

Issue: Sexual Harassment & Gender Discrimination

Sexual Harassment is a very big issue this quarter, with all the nationwide attention to the issue.

Program: HIV. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that a Lake County man is accused of transmitting HIV to a teenager he allegedly sexually assaulted. Aired 10/28 at 6:00am.

Program: Sexual Misconduct. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that a Chicago probation officer has been sentenced to one year in jail after admitting to inappropriate sexual contact with a woman who was on probation. Aired 11/4 at 6:00am.

Program: Pastor. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that a pastor of a Chicago church has resigned after revealing that he sexually abused an underage female relative when he was a teenager. Aired 11/7 at 6:00am.

Issue: Taxes

Two things are inevitable – death and taxes. In this issue, we discuss the latter.

Program: Tax Levy. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that the city of Ottawa is requesting an over six percent increase to their tax levy. Aired 12/4 at 8:00am. Broadcast a twenty second update informing listeners that Ottawa City Council's tax levy for 2020 will increase nine-point-five percent over the amount extended last year. Aired 12/18 at 6:00am and 8:00am.

Program: Marijuana Sales Tax. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that the city of LaSalle is gearing up to collect potential marijuana sales tax and has implemented a three percent sales tax. Aired 12/31 at 6:00am.

Issue: Tourism

Tourism is very important to the area for tourists coming in, as Starved Rock State Park is renowned as the "Crown Jewel" of the Illinois State Park System, and draws many tourists on the weekends. And tourism from the area is important to our listeners because as Mark Twain once said, "Travel is fatal to prejudice, bigotry, and narrow-mindedness."

Program: Pebbles. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that Buffalo Rock State Park could be getting a friend for Pebbles the bison. Aired 11/5 at 6:00am.

Program: Celebration of Lights. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that the Celebration of Lights in LaSalle opens up Friday Night at Rotary Park. Aired 11/15 at 6:00am and 8:00am. Broadcast a two hour live event at the Celebration of Lights encouraging listeners to attend and see the light displays. Aired 11/22 from 5:00pm until 7:00pm, 12/13 from 5:00pm until 7:00pm, and 12/20 from 5:00pm until 7:00pm.

Issue: Traffic

Transportation is very important to the area, especially with the important crossroads of two highly trafficked interstates.

Program: Seasonal Work. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that the Illinois Department of Transportation is offering seasonal work for its winter highway clearing program. Aired 10/8 at 6:00am.




