SINCE THE EARLY 90'S KMGK HAS COORDINATED THESE WITH THE POPE COUNTY COLLABORATIVE AND INTERNALLY AND HAS INTERVIEWED THE FOLLOWING:

MINNEWASKA SHOWSTOPPERS, OVARAN CANCER, BROOTEN COMMERCIAL CLUB, POPE COUNTY THANKSGIVING COMMUNITY DINNER, POPE COUNTY SHERRIF'S DEPT,

GLENWOOD POLICE DEPT., RACHEL'S CHALLENGE, NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY, AND OVER THE PAST 29 YEARS MANY MORE.

KMGK HAS DEDICATED ITSELF TO BEING A LOCAL RADIO STATION AND PRIDES ITSELF ON PROVIDING ADEQUATE TIME AND EXPOSURE TO ALL AREA NON-PROFITS, DEPATMENTS AND GOVERNING BODIES THE THEM WITH EVERY OPPORTUNITY TO DISCUSS AND PRESENT THEIR CONCERNS AND ISSUES. IN THE PAST MONTHS KMGK AND IT'S STAFF HAVE SPECIFICALLY INVOLVED AREA ENTITIES THE OPPOURTUNITY TO DISCUSS SEVERAL KEY ISSUES. THEY INCLUDE: GLENWOOD WINTERAMA, WATERAMA POLAR PLUNGE, NUMEROUS COMMUNITY COUNCIL MEETINGS, RED CROSS DONATION SITES AND DATES, HUMANE SOCIETY FUNDRAISER, BOY SCOUT AND GIRY SCOUT, LIONS CLUB, AND VFW SUPPERS AND FUNDRAISERS, AREA FIRE DEPT. EVENTS, NUMEROUS CHURCH SUPPERS AND SCHOOL EVENTS. SEVERAL ANNUAL MEETING ANNOUNCEMENTS, INCLUDING MUTUAL INSURANCE COMPANIES, HISTORICAL SOCIETY, AUDUBON SOCIETY, AND VARIOUS CIVIC GROUPS, SUCH AS THE AREA AMBULANCE SERVICE. ALSO THIS PAST QUARTER, KMGK HAS BEEN

ASKED TO ANNOUNCE CRIME RELATED ALERTS, INCLUDING A CHILD ABDUCTION AND MISING PERSON ALERT.

KMGK HAS RECENTLY BECOME A RADIO AFFILIATE WITH THE RED RIVER FARM NETWORK AND WITH THAT RELATIONSHIP HAS A BETTER ABILITY TO REALATE KET AGRICULTURAL UPDATES AND ANALYSIS TO IT'S AG LISTENERS. MONDAY – FRIDAY 2 DAILY PROGRAMS HAVE BEEN ADDED TO THE LINE UP. 'A COUNTRY MORNING' AND 'AG COUNTRY TODAY'. COUNRY MORNING FROM 6:30 – 7:00 AM EACH DAY PROVIDES KEY INTERVIEWS AND MARKET REPORTS AND AREA WEATHER. AG TODAY IS AT 12:30 PM EACH DONE AND IT IS A 1'2 HOUR PROGRAM AS WELL, AND ALSO UPDATES MARKETS, WEATHER, FARM NEWS AND RELATED INTERVIEWS AND REPORTS.

WITH SEVERAL MAJOR HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS IN THE IMMEDIATE AREA, KMGK HAS DISCUSSED THEM WITH LOCAL AND COUNTY OFFICIALS AND KEPT THE PUBLIC INFORMED OF VARIOUS REROUTING AND DETOUR DIRECTIVES. LOCAL POLICE AND SHERRIF'S OFFICIALS HAVE BEEN AVAILABLE FOR DIRECTIVES AND SPECIFIC DISCUSSIONS ABOUT VARIOUS CHANGES AND NEW ROAD RELATED MARKINGS AND RESTRICIONS. EXAMPLE-ROUNDABOUTS. THIS HAS BEEN VERY BENEFICIAL TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC. RECENTLY AN OPEN HOUSE WAS HELD BY THE MINNESOTA DEPT OF TRANSPORTATION AND KMGK PROMOTED AND HIGHLIGHTED THE MANY DETOUR INSTRUCTIONS AND PUBLIC NOTICES AND WILL BE DOING SO DURING THE ENTIRE CONSTRUCTION SEASON ON THE EXTENDED HWY 29 OVERPASS PROJEC THERE IN GLENWOOD. AND WITH SPRING ROAD RESTRICTIONS NOW IN FORCE, KMGK PROVIDES PUBLIC AWARENESS OF THE REQUIRMENTS AND STAEAND DATES.

OVER THE PAST FEW YEARS, KMGK HAS ADDED A WEEKLY FRIDAY MORNING PROGRAM THAT INVOLVES THE BONANZA VALLEY AREA THE OPPORTUNITY TO PROMOTE THEIR ACTIVITIES AND NON PROFIT EVENTS. CALLED "THE VOICE", STATION OWNER STEVE NESTR AND BONANZA VALLEY VOICE ADITOR RANDY OLSON DISCUSS MANY VARIED "VALLEY" HAPPENINGS AND NEWS ITEMS. THE TOWNS OF BROOTEN, BELGRADE AND ELROSA ARE COVERED AS WELL AS THE SURROUNDING RURAL AREAS.

KMGK ACTIVELY WORKS WITH THE GLENWOOD CHAMBER OF COMMERCE IN PROMOTING THEIR CITY WIDE ACTIVITIES AND EVENTS.

KMGK, DURING THE SPRING CONSTRUCTION SEASON, IS DIRECTLY IN CONTACT WITH THE MINNESOTA HIGHWAY DEPT AS WELL AS MANY AREA COUNTY

DEPT. FOR WEATHER RELATED ROAD CONDITIONS AND ANNOUCEMENTS. KMGK IS ALSO THE OFICIAL LOCAL MEDIA FOR BROADCASTING SCHOOL CLOSINGS AND DELAYS. KMGK PROVIDES THIS SERVICE TO ALL SYSTMES IN ITS COVERAGE AREA. THAT TOTALS WELL OVER A DOZEN SCHOOL SYSTEMS.

KMGK, NOW STARTING IT'S 30TH YEAR, WILL CONTINUE TO ALWAYS BE A PART OF THE LOCAL EFFORTS TO INSURE SAFETY, COOPERATION AND THE WELL BEING OF IT'S PARTNER ORGANIZATIONS, GOVERNING BODIES AND OFFICIALS AND ESPECIALLY IT'S CITIZENS.

KMGK HAS BEEN A PART OF RADIOTHONS WITH NON- PROFITS SEVERAL TIMES IN ITS 29 YEARS, INCLUDING UNITED WAY, ALZHEIMERS ASSOCIATION, POPE COUNTY HELP COUNCIL AND AMERICAN CANCER SOCIETY.

DURING THE EARLY SPRING AND SUMMER SEASON THERE ARE MANY CIVIC ORGANIZATION PROMOTIONS AND FUND RAISERS. THEY INCLUDE: KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS FISH FRYS, V.F.W CHOP AND STEAK FEEDS, CHURCH PANCKE AND SAUSAGE FEEDS, FIRE DE[ARTMENT DINNERS, SALAVTION ARMY FOOD BOXES, WEST CENTRAL RESEARCH STUDENT EMPLOYMENT NOTICES, LIONS CLUB FISH FRYS, MINN. HISTORICAL SOCIETY SIRE OPENINGS, LOCAL AUDUBON SOCIETY MONTHLY MEETINGS, CHAMBER OF COMMERCE ANNUAL MEETINGS, COMMUNITY FESTIVALS AND CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS, SEVERAL COMMUNITY MEMORIAL DAY CEREMONIES AND PARDES, SENIOR CITIZEN AND FOOD SHELF ANNOUNCEMENTS, LOCAL STATE PARK OPENINGS AND EVENTS, LOCAL CLOTHES CLOSET SALES AND PROMOTIONS, ANNUAL COOPERATIVE MEETING NOTIFICATIONS, AND PRE FOURTH OF JULY ACTIVITY NOTICES AND ANOUNCEMENTS. KMGK PROVIDED UPTO DATE NOTICES, WARNINGS, DICTATES AND SAFETY MESSAGES AND MANY HOURS OF BROADCASTING NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE ALARMS AND WARNINGS. AS A RESULT OF THE STORMS DAMAGES, KMGK RELAYED MANY PRESS RELEASES AND MESSAGES FROM LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AND MANAGEMENT & WEATHER SERVICES ABOUT STORM CLEAN UP, DISPOSAL AND CLEAN UP SITES.

THE DYNAMICS OF LOCALLY OWNED AND OPERATED RADIO ALLOWS KMGK TO BE UP TO THE MINUTE AND AVAILABLE FOR SEASONAL WEATHER, COMMUNITY AND COUNTY WIDE ANNOUNCEMENTS AND NOTIFICATIONS. THIS ABILITY IS UNFORTUNATELY BEING LOST BY MANY MULTI OWNED AUTOMATED CORPORATE STATIONS.
