8/13/23 at 11:00-11:30am: Does L.A. County's zero-bail policy for non-violent offenders mean zero consequences? When it comes to shop owners and workers, what's legal and what's not when it comes to stopping thieves in their tracks? Can a shrinking LAPD address this growing problem? Guest speaker: LAPD Chief Michel Moore.

9/17/23 at **11:00-11:30am:** With COVID cases again on the rise in L.A. County, the public health director told us wat she's seeing and if masking could again be required. Guest speaker: Barbara Ferrer, director of the county's Department of Public Health.

9/24/23 at 11:00-11:30pm: Whether it's anxiety or depression, one out of every five Americans suffers from some type of mental health issue. In Los Angeles County alone, that's two million people.
