This *private* botanical heaven will be open to the public for visitation each day of the ArtFields competition, excluding Sunday, April 24. Moreover, Moore Farms will be hosting two signature events to kick off the 10th year ArtFields celebration on Saturday, April 23. They begin with "Yoga in the Garden" (\$35 per person) at 9:30am, followed by their biannual "Evening Wine Walk" event (free) from 3:00pm-7:00pm.
