



FOX 10 Xtra News airs 1 hour of live news each weekday @ 7PM. In addition, the station produces a 2 hour streaming live news show each weekday @ 10AM, "FOX 10 News Now."

This report highlights the issues that were of greatest importance during the months of January, February, and March 2020.

On the chart that follows we list the stories we covered in these topic areas including the date, specific newscast and on-air format. Here is a key to estimate how much time we allocated to each story:

RDR = reader

Anchor reads script with no video. Typically 20 seconds

VO = anchor voice-over

Anchor reads script with video. Typically 20-30 seconds

VOSOT = anchor voice-over/"sound on tape"

Anchor reads script with video. Story includes sound bite from interview subject. Usually 45 seconds

LIVE VO = live voice over

Reporter live in the studio or field with extended video and information. Typically 1 minute

LIVE VOSOT = live voice over/"sound on tape"

Reporter live in the studio or field with extended video and sound bite from interview subject. Usually 1 minute, 45 seconds

PKG = reporter package

A self-contained story narrated by an anchor or reporter

An anchor usually introduces the story

Including anchor introductions, stories typically run 1 minute, 30 seconds

LIVE PKG = live reporter including reporter package

Same as PKG above, except a reporter introduces the story live from the scene

AUDIO HAS BEEN RELEASED OF STATE REPRESENTATIVE JAY LAWRENCE MAKING REMARKS ABOUT REFUGEES COMING TO ARIZONA, WHICH HAVE UPSET SOME PEOPLE. TONIGHT WE'RE HEARING FROM HIM ABOUT WHAT HE HAD TO SAY. "I don't want refugees settled here. I don't feel as though they come here ... they will take from us." You just heard the voice of State representative Jay Lawrence speaking at a political event in Fountain Hills last week. The audio from the event released by a liberal Super Pac - American Bridge 21st Century. At the event - Lawrence says he'd do all he could to not accept a refugee population in the state "Call me a bigot, whatever you want, I just think it's best for the state of Arizona" Today, Representative Lawrence walked back his comments when he sat down with us "I misspoke, I absolutely misspoke, and I take the blame" Lawrence didn't completely back away, however, still saying he had questions about people who resettle here. "My thoughts deal with, I don't know that I trust the federal government to send us all wonderful refugees, they're all charming, wonderful, legal. I don't know if it's that true. I don't know if there aren't spies among them, people who want to do us harm" State democrats blasted the comments and cited a resolution passed unanimously last year supporting refugees Rep. Athena Salman/(D) Tempe: "I was really disappointed, I think last year, last session, the House took a significant step, all 60 members proclaimed Arizona as a welcoming state for refugees" "Are you a bigot?" "No. you look at the bills I've supported, the bills I've written and bigotry is not even in my ballpark, I am absolute...that's...you say things and you say "Hey i'll fix you you think I'm a bigot?" no...not even close."

THE TUNNEL STRETCHES MORE THAN THREE-QUARTERS OF A MILE FROM TIJUANA, MEXICO, INTO THE SAN DIEGO AREA. IT WAS FOUND IN LATE AUGUST LAST YEAR. THE TUNNEL HAS AN EXTENSIVE RAIL CAR SYSTEM, FORCED AIR VENTILATION, ELECTRICITY AND AN ELEVATOR. AFTER ITS DISCOVERY, MEXICAN AND UNITED STATES LAW ENFORCEMENT BEGAN MAPPING THE TUNNEL SYSTEM. THE ARRR ELOOKING TO BUILD A 30-FOOT STEEL WALL ALONG THE SOUTHERN BORDER. BORDER PATROL SAYS THE CONTROLLED BLASTING IS TARGETED AND WILL CONTINUE FOR THE REST OF THE MONTH AT DIFFERENT INTERVALS. THIS IS PART OF THE TRUMP ADMINISTRATION'S NEW "PUBLIC CHARGE RULE", WHICH FAVORS WEALTHIER IMMIGRANTS SEEKING PERMANENT STATUS. ONE IN PHOENIX AND THE OTHER IN GLENDALE. IN THE WEST VALLEY, FAMILY MEMBERS FOUND A CHILD IN THE WATER AT A HOME NEAR 67TH AVENUE AND CAMELBACK. A FAMILY MEMBER TOLD FIREFIGHTERS THE CHILD HAD BEEN MISSING FOR ABOUT 5 MINUTES. "They went outside located the patient in the pool, which was a child, jumped in pulled the child out of the pool, called 911 and started cpr. when units got on scene they found the family member doing cpr and went ahead and took over." 3/18/20	7PM	PKG	STATE LAWMAKERS BUSY TRYING TO FIGURE OUT WHAT HAPPENS IF ARIZONA SCHOOLS STAY CLOSED PAST MARCH 30TH. THE TWO WEEK CLOSURE IS LIKELY TO GO MUCH LONGER. MATT RODEWALD HAS THE STORY. Two years ago.. And today silence no one on the law and all is quiet minus a few vacuums on the house floor at the Arizona State Capitol. Amidst the coronavirus stranglehold, lawmakers are trying to figure out how to proceed with the school year. Quite possibly the most important piece of education legislation the state has seen since Red For Ed, but just because it's all quiet doesn't mean that lawmakers aren't hearing from constituents. Michelle Udall is a part of a joint proposal that would clarify what's next for Arizona schools. March 30th is the key date. If schools return to session before March 30th, would waive schedule requirements, extend the AZ Merit testing window to the end of May and alleviate the weight of letter grades. But if schools don't go back...it would mandate schools use other formats for learning, statewide testing would be wiped out, and teachers would get paid the rest of the year. Udall zeroes in on the impact of test assessment.

PRESIDENT DONALD TRUMP: "We're going to protect our families, we're going to protect our children and we're going to protect the industry." THE TRUMP ADMINISTRATION ANNOUNCING TODAY THAT FRUIT, CANDY AND DESSERT FLAVORED SMALL, CARTRIDGE-BASED E-CIGARETTES THAT ARE TYPICALLY POPULAR WITH HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS ARE NO LONGER ALLOWED TO BE SOLD.
