Position Details

Primary Duties/Responsibilities:

The Producer adds stories to OPB's CMS from all sources available to OPB including both internal content units and external content providers. During this shift, the producer is responsible for managing content placement on OPB's digital platforms, editing copy, compiling a morning news headlines email newsletter, coordinating breaking news updates with broadcast staff, push alerts,

and monitoring online comments on local stories. The producer will coordinate with individual reporters on responses to specific comments on their stories.

Working Conditions:
