## **Position Details**

## **Primary Duties/Responsibilities:**

Develop sources and enterprising story ideas on the environmental beat, meeting OPB's ethical, technical, legal and aesthetic standards. The primary outlet for all work will be the EarthFix network, which includes digital/online, radio and television.

## **Working Conditions:**

The reporter is based <u>at Jefferson Public Radio in Ashland</u>, Oregon. <u>They will</u> divide time between an office/studio and fieldwork as needed for newsgathering, which may include travel to remote locations, working evening or weekends, and possibly working in inclement weather. Lifting and carrying equipment up to 40 lbs. is sometimes required. Some extended periods of standing and walking may be required. Frequent in-state travel and some out-of-state travel <u>are</u> required.
