Dear Mr. Swidler:

This is in reference to the request filed on December 20, 2023. WHYL requests a further extension of the STA granted on September 17, 2014, to continue operating from an alternate site to allow time to file the required 301-AM minor change application in LMS (due to loss of the licensed site). In support of the request, WHYL stated that related field measurements have been completed, and therefore it hopes to be able to file the ND proposal application in early 2024.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and WHYL may continue to operate with the following facilities:

The records shall include start/stop dates and times of such operation. These log entries must be maintained for a minimum of two years as specified in 47 CFR § 73.1840(a), unless a longer retention period is requested by the staff. Periods of operation may be subject to independent verification that they in fact occurred.
