On behalf of WHYL, Inc., licensee of the above-referenced station, you are respectfully requested to extend special temporary authority for station WHYL to continue operating at an alternate tower site at 1.3 kW day, 0.022 kW night nondirectional due to the loss of the licensed site.

WHYL is a small market AM station licensed to a small business and operating at reduced power with a commensurately reduced service area and revenue potential.


The WHYL consulting engineer, Morgan Burrow, advises that he is now working on preparing the Form 301 construction permit application for licensed operation which we will file as soon as we are able.

An STA extension is in the public interest as it permits WHYL to continue to serve the public with an important broadcast voice while searching for a viable licensed tower site and prepares to resume licensed broadcast operation.
