2	Participate in event sponsored by educational institution relating to careers in broadcasting	Our SEU was invited to participate in a virtual guest lecture series at the University of Central Oklahoma. On October 06, 2020, our KYIS Program Director spoke to Mass Communications/Programming students via a virtual conference. Topics included FCC rules and regulations, programming philosophies, sales tactics, promotional success stories, and engineering, including how the SEU was broadcasting from home during a pandemic.
