WPNA 103.1 FM Programs Addressing Public and Community Issues

During the third quarter of 2022, WPNA's bilingual (Polish/English) programming addressed the following issues of concern to the public:

1. Morning with 103.1 FM (July 7, 8:00 a.m., segment duration 4 min.)

Issue of concern: Unhealthy eating

Morning show hosts, Mateusz Pankiewicz and Wiktoria Kitner, discussed the topic of unhealthy eating, including the latest diets and dietary trends. The issue of keeping a healthy lifestyle when leading a busy, professional life, including the everyday challenges such as, for example, finding unprocessed cooking ingredients, was widely debated, with listeners interacting with the hosts via text messages.
